Grand Council Annual Business Assembly

April 21, 2007 Masonic Temple Portsmouth

The Grand Council was opened in due form by MI Grand Master Companion Dennis A. Sheridan at 10:00 a.m. following the annual meeting of the Order of the Silver Trowel which met at 9:00 a.m.

A roll call of Officers was held and all Councils had at least one credited representative present. Filling in for missing Grand Officers were Companion C. Jarvis Lewis, Jr., Grand Chaplain as Grand Principle Conductor of the Works, and James S. Geas, Deputy Grand Lecturer as Grand Captain of the Guard. There were 7 Most Illustrious Past Grand Masters in attendance.

The following reports were read and accepted: Report of the Grand Treasurer, Publicity and Public Relations, Finance Committee, Budget Report, Life Membership Committee, and the Grand Lecturer's Report. A motion was made to publish the missing Grand Officer's reports and pass them out at the Annual on May 12th. This motion was seconded and voted in favor of passing. All other reports will be given at the annual including Doings of Grand Officers, Grand Master's Message, Jurisprudence Committee, Grand Treasurer's report, and Report of Fraternal Correspondence.

A Commission for Grand Representative of the Grand Council of Missouri near the Grand Council of New Hampshire was presented to Ill. Companion Walter P. Sword, Grand Steward, for his work in Cryptic Masonry. He was then accorded the Private Grand Honors by the Companions before returning to his seat.

The Companions of Evening Star Council No. 13 of Colebrook, NH, presented a Certificate of Acknowledgement to MIPGM Companion Arnold M. Ashley and he was made an Honorary Member and Past Illustrious Master of that Council. Companion Ashley gave that Body the 'kick in the Rear' that began the rejuvenation of that Council. The Most Illustrious Grand Master approved this request with extreme pride.

Letters of "retirement" from our Grand Treasurer and Grand Recorder were read, and public announcement made of two companions willing to assume those stations next term. A motion to give Companions Emerson and Ashley Emeritus status was tabled until the Annual Assembly.

Dispensations

I approved a by-laws change to allow Olivet Council No. 11 of Exeter to meet quarterly instead of monthly.

I approved a request for Dispensation to allow Evening Star Council No. 13 of Colebrook to meet quarterly and jointly with North Star Chapter No. 16 RAM of Lancaster and North Star-St. Gerard Commandery Knights Templar of Littleton for three of those meetings. This Dispensation is only for the year 2007 and if they desire to continue the practice, a request to change the by-laws of that Body will have to be presented to that Grand Council's Committee. Also, depending on joint approval from the Grand Chapter and the Grand Commandery.

I approved a request for Dispensation to allow Evening Star Council No. 13 of Colebrook to vote on a proposed bylaws change in less than the 28 days their by-laws required. Because of the last Dispensation's effects, their next Assembly was held in 26 days. To wait until the next one was several months, and in my opinion would be against the best interests of the Council.

I approved a request to allow Evening Star Council to elect Most Illustrious Past Grand Master Arnold M. Ashley to Honorary Membership in that Council, as a thank you for being the jump start of that Council's revitalization.

Grand Council Projects

I was pleased to be received in a Council of Super Excellent Masters last June in Concord. A Degree Team with several members from my Home Council did the work. It is my hope that the Grand Council will continue to support this Annual endeavor and perhaps encouraging a better attendance.

I was highly honored to lead a New Hampshire Degree team to Barre, Vermont to perform the Royal Master Degree at a Multi-State Grand Council Festival. Several Companions from Evening Star Council, with assistance from my Grand Officers, went over to support your Grand Masters' Team. We were then pleased to observe degree teams from Rhode Island do the Select Master Degree and from Maine do the Super Excellent Master Degree. A thoroughly well done performance.

Grand Council/Grand Chapter Publicity Committee reports again went out in some kind of timely fashion. Unfortunately, I did not always have time to do as much reporting as usual, as I had to spend a lot of hours doing Masonic labors for the Grand Council and other Masonic Bodies. However, I am not getting any requests to advertise events from the bodies. I hope that will change over the next year.

My favorite subject has been the promotion of Grand Officer training sessions. The purpose of this is to assist the incoming Officers with knowledge that may not always be passed down. The following subjects are my favorites: protocol, dress code, officer knowledge, respect, brotherly love and teamwork. A course for Junior Officers will be presented for the incoming Grand Officers. This is not a closed course for Grand Officers only. Any Companion may participate if he wishes, information is good for all.

We have had three training sessions last year, which covered a lot of material. I encourage those who missed them to put them down on your calendars for the future. They are being done for your benefit.

I will list my Masonic calendar and regrets separately for publishing.

Recommendations

That the Councils promote inter visitation to aid them in their presentations and for moral support. They should endeavor to look for new blood in doing their degree work. The same Past Masters are still doing the work from the last century. How about encouraging some new Officer to do that work. You may be surprised to find out that he can do a good job.

That the York Rite Council continue to develop the Officer Training Program being offered to the Grand Line Officers and encourage their support by the members.

That the Grand Council Super Excellent Master Degree Team continues to do the good work it does. I will continue to volunteer my services to directing this endeavor, if it is the wish of the Grand Council.

Food for Thought

When your Presiding Grand Officers decided to end the York Rite Festivals to encourage the work to be done in the Home Bodies, it was with the thought that each Council would do their best to get the work done well. Sometimes the work is being done, but due to absences, or lack of rehearsals, the performance is not always up to par. Please remember that we are doing this work for the candidate and he must get the best impression possible if we are to make him an active member. If assistance in that regard is needed, ask your Grand Line Officers for advice. We must do the best ritual work we can if we are to continue on into the next century.

Closing

It has been an honor for me to serve as your Most Illustrious Grand Master. Most of you know I have many titles this year including Worshipful Master again. Because of this any various other reasons, I will not serve a second term. I have received letters from our Grand Treasure Wallace F. Emerson and our Grand Recorder Arnold M. Ashley announcing their intention to step down as of this next term. In that regard, I offer my eligibility to be considered for the job of Grand Recorder next year, if someone considers me worthy of nomination for the position. I want to thank Most Illustrious Companions Ashley and Emerson for their many years of dedicated service to this Grand Body and hope to see them each elected as Emeritus Members of this Body for their respective positions. We wish you many more years of happiness as “retired” Grand Officers.

I wish to thank the Companions of the State for their support. Special recognition goes to Evening Star Council for their support of me this last year. I thank the Grand Officers for their efforts to promote Cryptic Masonry here in New Hampshire. And I especially wish to thank my wife, Dotty, and daughter Amanda, without whose support I would never have been able to accomplish what we have done.
