Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect its physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate. Senior Earthdog: Open only to dogs that have acquired the Junior or Master Earthdog Title.

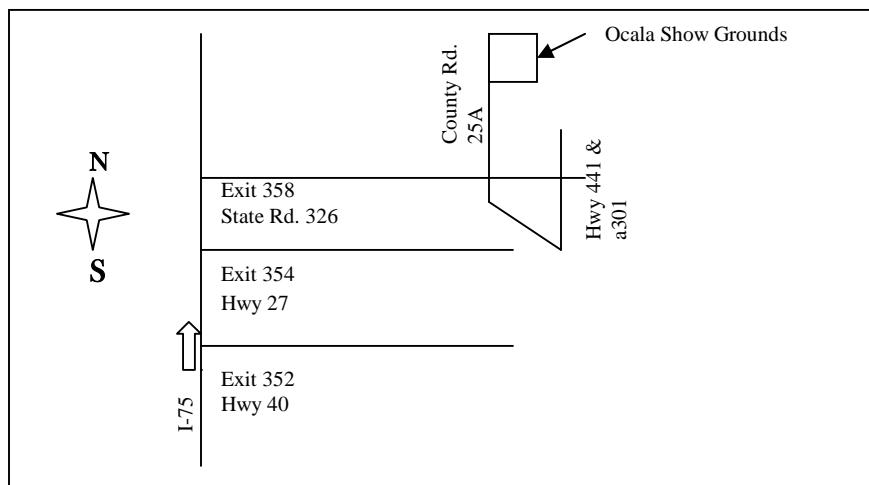
Master Earthdog: Open only to dogs that have acquired the Senior or Master Earthdog Titles.

Any dogs entered that qualify for Junior Earthdog or Senior Earthdog titles prior to the day of the test may move up to the next level by contacting the secretary prior to the day of the test.

Bitches in season shall not be eligible to participate. Full refund of entry fees will be made if the test secretary is notified before the closing date. If notice is received after closing date, refund will be made, less \$5.00 provided the test secretary receives notice prior to the test.

NO substitutions or refunds will be allowed after closing
