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Day of Test Entries: Introduction to Quarry closes at 8:45 AM each day; Junior Earthdog closes at 9:30 AM each day. **Move-up Entries** close on Wednesday February 6, 2008 for Saturday, February 9th test and at the close of test on Saturday February 9th for Sunday, February 10th test. Please notify the test secretary if you have a move-up.

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date for any class or in the event that a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such dismissal, except for bitches in season (See Dogs Eligible To Enter). Dogs may enter only one regular class at an Earthdog test, except dogs which have earned a Master Earthdog Title may enter more than one regular class (Regular classes are classes from which the dogs may earn titles, i.e. JE, SE, ME). No further AKC title certificates will be awarded.

AWARDS

Qualifying rosettes will be provided for qualifying rounds in all titling classes. A pale green ribbon will be awarded to any dog successfully completing the Introduction to Quarry test. In addition, titling rosettes will be awarded for any dog completing a title.

Special Recognition will be given to any "Iron Earthdog" passing SE & ME on the same day in the honor of Raleigh Mallik and to any "Enduro Earthdog" passing JE, SE and ME on the same day in honor of Buddy Markle. All Special Recognition Awards are presented by "The Atlanta Terrier Club, Inc." (ATC) and **ARE NOT** recognized awards by "The American Kennel Club, Inc." (AKC).

CHECK-IN AND RUNNING ORDER

Self-check-in for all classes will begin at 7:45 AM each day.

- Master Earthdog: Check-In before 8:30 AM, Brace Drawing Promptly at 8:30 AM, Orientation at 8:45 AM, Testing after Orientation
- Introduction to Quarry: Orientation for Group A 9:00 AM, Group B 9:15 AM, Testing after Orientation
- Senior Earthdog: Orientation at 9:30 AM, Testing after Orientation

- Junior Earthdog: Orientation at 9:45 AM, Testing after Orientation

Exhibitors must check in prior to the start of their class. Dogs will run in the order received except Master Earthdog with consideration given to multiple dogs with the same handler, the same dog (ME Titled) in multiple tests and to event volunteers. There is no guarantee dogs entered in Intro to Quarry will test in Intro to Quarry before regular class test. If you are late to the gate and miss your scheduled test time you will be moved to the end of the running order. You will not be counted absent until the testing judge has given opportunity to all present at the Gate Steward to test their dog. The test for that class will then be concluded and any dog not present will be counted as absent. The Test Committee reserves the right to modify the test running order to keep the events moving smoothly.

TEST SITE & FACILITIES

Jim Miller Park is a large public park and equestrian facility. It is part of the Cobb County, Georgia Parks and Recreation Department. We have access to and will use a climate controlled building (small arena size) for registration, administration and awards ceremonies. The building is equipped with men's & women's restrooms and has ample space inside to crate your dogs, especially if the weather is cold and or nasty. There are many parking spaces available for RV's. However, if the temperatures are well below freezing the water hookups will be a problem. Contact the Test Chairperson for help with any RV questions. The regular automobile parking lot is very large. It is mostly stone and gravel with NO SHADE. The entire test grounds will be isolated with barrier tape, and it will be very easy to find your way around.

The Senior and Master tunnels and most of the Master walk-up are located in the woods. The only barriers are natural. It is a wonderful hunting experience for you and your dog. Pictures of the grounds, test area and past Earthdog Tests can be found on the club's website: www.atlantaterrierclub.org

Our Test Committee is very proud to have such a wonderful public facility available for our test. The park employees have placed many garbage barrels on the grounds for our use. Please pick up after yourself and your dog(s). We desire to maintain a high credibility with Cobb County, so that AKC Events of all kinds will continue to be welcomed.

DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE

FROM I-75: Exit Windy Hill Road (GA Exit 260). Go West to dead end (approx 6.3 miles), Turn Left on Austell Road (Hwy. 5), Go approx ½ mile, Turn Right on Callaway Road, Jim Miller Park is ½ mile on the right.

FROM I-20: Headed east on I-20 toward Atlanta, after passing (GA Hwy 92) exit at Douglasville, go to the second exit (Exit 44), Thornton Road (GA Hwy 6) and turn Left. Go approx 1 mile and turn Right on Maxham Road. Maxham Road changes to Austell Road (GA Hwy 5). From Thornton Road, continue on Maxham Road/Austell Road approx 5 miles and you will see the

WellStar Cobb Hospital on our Left, continue on Austell road approx 2.5 miles and turn Left on Callaway Road. Jim Miller Park is ½ mile on the right.

CLASS INFORMATION

(All classes except Intro to Quarry count towards AKC Titling Qualifications)

Introduction to Quarry: (non-regular class) Open to all eligible breeds. Junior Earthdog: Open to all eligible breeds. Senior Earthdog: Open only to dogs that acquired a Junior Earthdog Title. Master Earthdog: Open only to dogs that have acquired a Senior Earthdog Title.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Dogs six months of age or older and registered with the American Kennel Club are eligible to participate in earthdog tests, as are spayed and neutered dogs. The following breeds are classified as eligible to participate in earthdog tests:

Dogs of an eligible breed that have been granted [Indefinite Listing Privileges \(ILP\)](#) are eligible to participate. A dog of an eligible breed with an acceptable foreign registration number is eligible to participate subject to [Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Dog Show Rules](#).

Inasmuch as Dachshunds and Terriers are hunting dogs, dogs disfigured as the result of accident or injury but otherwise qualified shall be eligible provided that the disfigurement does not interfere with functional movement. Dogs that are blind and/or deaf shall not be eligible. Blind means without useful vision, and deaf means without useful hearing.

Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test; and may not be on the test grounds. Entry fees will be refunded (minus the \$3.00 AKC fee) for bitches in season with a Veterinary Authorization or presentation of the bitch to the Test Committee at the registration and administration building ONLY. Request for refund must be made prior to 8:00 AM Saturday February 9, 2008.

A dog is not eligible to enter a test if the Judge of that test or any member of that Judge's family owns or co-owns the dog. The word "family" shall include a spouse, a sibling, a parent or a child, whether natural or adopted, of the Judge in question but shall not extend to other blood or legal relations.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AKC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this test. The organizing committee may refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with AKC will not be allowed entry in the test.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 fee for any check returned.

Exhibitors who do not clean up after their dogs at the site or at their motels may be dismissed from the test.

The Atlanta Terrier Club, Inc. (ATC) members/workers/officers will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Test Committee be asked to leave the test site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" and the "Earthdog Regulations" have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents, I (we) waive any and all claims and causes of action that I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge judging at this test, under AKC rules, regulations, and guidelines. I(we) agree that the club holding this earthdog test has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the earthdog test and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or test secretary, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the agility test premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I(we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I(we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless for any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and for any claim for damage, or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, or injury be caused or be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

INSTRUCTIONS

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

(Actual Owners) A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a test closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any test for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
