PLEASE NOTE: to allow time for everyone, dogs will be allowed to train only in the class they are currently competing in &/or as follows:

◆Dogs with one Junior leg may train in Senior

◆Dogs with two Senior legs may train in Master

9:00-10:30 Master Earthdog: run throughs may be individual or in braces depending on the readiness of each dog

9:30-11:00 Introduction to Quarry: two divisions

◆above ground introduction to quarry & tunnels

◆introduction to underground tunnels

9:00-11:00 Search & Partnership Level I

11:00-12:00 Break

12:30-2:00 Junior Earthdog: Run throughs & graduated length to 30'

12:00-2:00 Senior Earthdog: Recall training and run throughs

12:00-2:00 Search & Partnership, Level II (Must pass Level I to enter)
