Registrations should be received by April 1, 2003. Any registrations received after April 1 will be assessed a \$50 late fee.

After registration, you will receive a confirmation letter with your site placement. About a month before your **SUMMIT**, you will receive a welcome letter with additional information of what to bring/not to bring, directions, emergency phone number, etc.

SUMMIT SITE ASSIGNMENTS START NOVEMBER 1, 2002

There are a limited number of spots at each **SUMMIT** location. **SUMMIT** site placements are made in accordance with your prioritized site requests on a first-come, first-served basis starting with applications received on or after November 1, 2002. So get your paid application or pre-registration deposit in early to increase the likelihood of getting into your first choice site.

PRE-REGISTRATION PROCESS FOR SUMMIT

You can pre-register to reserve spaces at **SUMMIT** locations with a \$125^{US}/\$150^{CAN} non-refundable deposit per person. On the bottom of the first page of the **SUMMIT** Registration, complete the Pre-Registration information, designate your 1st, 2nd, and 3rd choice of

SUMMIT sites, and send in your non-refundable deposit before February 1, 2003. The top portion of the first page of the **SUMMIT** Registration and the completed second page plus the balance of the registration fee must be received from each participant by April 1, 2003. Your site assignment cannot be guaranteed if the completed application and the balance of the registration fee are not received by April 1, 2003.

CANCELLATIONS

Youth Unlimited will refund monies based on the following cancellation policy:

180 days before the event: 75%

60 days before the event: 50%

30 days before the event: 25%

No refunds will be made for cancellations within 14 days of the event. Full refunds are given only for extenuating circumstances.

Please note that pre-registration deposits are non-refundable.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Conventioneers must be 14 years old or through grade 8 by July 4, 2003.
2. Base Camp Leaders (small group leaders) must be post-high school. All Base Camp Leaders ages 18-21 must also include a pastoral recommendation.
3. Crew members must be at least 19 years of age.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to and from the **SUMMIT** site is your own responsibility.

ROOMMATES

You may designate up to one other person with whom to room. Roommates should mail their registration forms in together.

NOTE TO ADULT REGISTRANTS

Youth Unlimited needs adults whose gifts are administration, hospitality or sports to participate as **CREW** members. Crew members are expected to provide 8-12 hours of service per day. When not on duty, Crew members may participate in any of the **SUMMIT** events. In return for their work, Crew members will receive a reduced registration fee. Crew members must be at least 19 years old. SUMMIT RULES

- Do not enter floors and rooms that house the opposite gender.
