Location: Expo New Mexico State Fairgrounds in Albuquerque, New Mexico

Fees: \$7 per animal per class for NMPGC members and \$9 per goat per class for non-members. Showmanship is \$2 with premiums of \$10 for 1^{st} place and \$5 for 2^{nd} place. Showmanship is held in the morning show only. No refunds will be given after entries are received. All in-state exhibitors must send a check with their entry. Futurity: This year we have included our 4 Sire Futurity classes into the a.m. show. We have offered this in the New Mexico Pygmy Goat Club for several years to improve/track breeding programs through the years. The New Mexico Sire Futurity offers 6 classes for wether, doe and buck kids between the ages of 2 and 6 months and 3 yearling classes for all those that entered and participated in last year's futurity. There are cash premiums for these classes. **YOU MUST HAVE ENTERED THIS FUTURITY LAST YEAR TO BE IN THESE CLASSES. IF YOU WANT TO ENTER NEXT YEAR, PLEASE SEE DAVE.**

Master Challenge: Please not the changes after NPGA June 2009 Director's Board Meeting. The Master Challenge will be for PGCH goats only. The Grand Champion of that show will NOT compete. If that Grand Champion finishes; that goat can compete at any following shows but not in Master Challenge class for that show. Show Arrival: The barn will be available after 12:00 p.m. on Friday, July 10, 2009. Animals can stay there both Friday and Saturday nights.

Show Schedule: Check-in will begin at 7:45 a.m. on Saturday, July 11 and <u>WILL</u> be completed by 8:45 a.m. The show <u>WILL</u> start promptly at 9:00 a.m.

Animal Identification: All animals must have original NPGA registration papers. Any animal winning a Grand or Reserve Grand Championship must have a legible tattoo or microchip.

Pens: Pens will be available for you to use. **ALL PENS MUST BE CLEANED OR THE NMPGC WILL BE CHARGED A CLEANING FEE OF \$10 A PEN.**

Sick animals: Any animals deemed ill by the NMPGC Executive Board or the contracted Judge will be withdrawn from the competition. Refunds will not be given. Please do not bring sick animals to the show.

Meals: The NMPGC will have morning donuts/pastries, snacks, sodas and coffee available for sale. We will have a potluck at lunchtime. Bring a potluck dish or dessert. The price is \$2 for anyone who donates to the potluck and \$5 for those who do not.

Raffle: We will have a raffle table with items available. Please bring something to contribute to our raffle table. All proceeds go to support the club.
