

New Mexico Pygmy Goat Club 2009 Sire Futurity

We are excited to invite you to participate in the 7th Annual New Mexico Pygmy Goat Club's Sire Futurity, which will be held in conjunction with our July 11, 2009 July Jubilee Show. The purpose of the Futurity is to improve our current breeding programs while maintaining the pygmy goat standard. We want to breed our animals in hopes of improving the quality of the offspring and enhancing their competitive level for future shows.

The club has decided to try something new for 2009 and will integrate the Futurity show into the morning show. We are also moving the Sunday show to Saturday afternoon following the first show. We felt the club and its members would receive the following benefits from combining the Futurity and the main show.

- Club and its members profit monetarily
- Additional \$275 fair rental fee for Sunday is removed from club expenses
- Futurity kids and yearlings can compete for recorded wins in the main show without extra expense to exhibitor
- Futurity participants will receive reasons by the judge for their kid's placing
- Out of state exhibitors can travel home early on Sunday

The 2009 Sire Futurity offers the following nine classes, which include one each yearling class for wethers, does and bucks that competed in the 2008 Sire Futurity. All classes receive monetary winnings for the 1st through 4th placing. Please note that these classes correspond to the show class sheet on Page 3.

Class 6A: Wethers (2 to 4 months) born March 13, 2009 through May 12, 2009 Wethers (4 to 6 months) born January 12, 2009 through March 12, 2009

Class 18A: Does (2 to 4 months) born March 13, 2009 through May 12, 2009
Class 19A: Does (4 to 6 months) born January 12, 2009 through March 12, 2009
Class 34A: Bucks (2 to 4 months) born March 13, 2009 through May 12, 2009
Class 35A: Bucks (4 to 6 months) born January 12, 2009 through March 12, 2009

Class 9A: Wether Yearlings from 2007 Futurity competition
Class 22A: Does Yearlings from 2007 Futurity competition
Class 38A: Does Yearlings from 2007 Futurity competition

Winnings for the Futurity classes are based on a percentage of the monies collected throughout the year for the buck, doe and litter nominations as well as the final Futurity show registrations. The yearling class winnings are based on a percentage of the sponsorship monies collected, which are usually \$100 for each class.

Again, the money received will be split between the 1st through 4th place winners and a portion will also go to the owners of all the sires whose kids participated in the competitions; sires for yearling animals are not included in the money split.

Also note that all Futurity kids are eligible to compete in the second show, but will compete in their regular classes.

Breeding Dates: August 19, 2008 through December 18, 2008

Requirements for Participation:

- All kids must be born between **January 12, 2009 and May 12, 2009** to compete (NO EXCEPTIONS).
- All kids must have a sire who has been nominated to participate. You can use your own buck or those of another breeder as long as the buck is nominated for the Futurity.
- All kids must be registered to compete. Registration papers will be reviewed at show check-in.
- All nominations (buck, doe and litter) and registrations must be paid before participation in the Futurity classes.

A list of all nominated bucks will be available October 15, 2008. If purchasing buck service, please verify with the owner that the buck is nominated for the Futurity.

Buck Nominations due October 1, 2008
Doe Nominations due March 15, 2009
Litter Nominations due June 1, 2009
Futurity Kid Registrations due July 1, 2009

New Mexico Pygmy Goat Club 2009 Sire Futurity General Rules

- 1. New Mexico Pygmy Goat Club is the governing authority for the Futurity. It is a sole and separate non-sanctioned event held in conjunction with the July sanctioned show.
- 2. Fees are NONREFUNDABLE; except in the event the Futurity is cancelled.
- 3. Any person with NFS checks not resolved prior to the start of the Futurity will not be allowed to show in the Futurity and will not be eligible for refunds of any fees.
- 4. Participation in this event is open to all owners of NPGA registered animals.
- 5. All animals will be judged by an NPGA judge using the NPGA breed standards.
- 6. Original registration certificates must be presented at Futurity check-in.
- 7. The sire and dam of futurity kids are not required to be entered in the July sanctioned show but are welcome and are encouraged to be shown.
- 8. Any grievance or protest must be submitted to the Futurity committee before going home the day of the Futurity show.
- 9. <u>Buck Nominations:</u> Open to any NPGA registered buck. Nomination applications must be completed and postmarked no later than **October 1, 2008**. Nomination fee per buck is \$25.00 and must be included.
- 10. <u>Doe Nominations:</u> Open to any NPGA registered doe. Nomination applications must be completed and postmarked no later than **March 15, 2009**. Nomination fee per doe is \$5.00 and must be included.
- 11. <u>Litter Nominations:</u> Open to litters of NMPGC 2009 Futurity nominated does bred to nominated NMPGC 2009 Futurity sires. Litter nominating form must be completed and postmarked no later than **June 1, 2009**. Nomination fee per litter is \$5.00 and must be included.
- 12. <u>Kid Nominations/Registrations:</u> Open to any kids born from the above nominated litters. Kid form must be completed and postmarked no later than **July 1, 2009**. Nomination fee per kid is \$10.00 and must be included.
