NORTHERN LIGHTS GOAT ASSOCIATION ADGA SHOW RULES

- 1. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and their rules shall govern. Only American Dairy goat Association, American Goat Society, and Canadian Goat Society registered, recorded or applied for animals that are recognized by ADGA as dairy animals may be shown.
- 2. The Senior Doe and Junior Doe shows are both separately sanctioned. The Buck shows are not sanctioned separately. DOES: Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Sable, Toggenburg, and Recorded Grade. BUCKS: Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen and Toggenburg.
- 3. The original Registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older. Animals under six months of age may be shown with the original registration certificate or a duplicate application stamped by the ADGA registry office. These certificates must be shown to the show secretary BEFORE THE START OF THE SHOW. No photocopies, telegrams or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.
- 4. The base date for determining the age of the animal is the date that the animal is being shown.
- 5. No dairy goats with horns may be shown.
- 6. The entry fee shall be \$4.00 per animal per class per day. If entering 10 or more animals each day, the entry fee shall be \$3.50 per animal per class per day. Pre-entry is not required, but would be greatly appreciated. The deadline for pre-entry is June 1, 2009. Late entries will be \$4.50 per animal per class per day, and there will be NO quantity discount for late entries. The entry fee for showmanship classes is \$1.00 per class provided that the animal is shown in regular breed classes. (Showmanship will be on Saturday only) There will be no refund of entry monies.
- 7. All out of state animals are required by Wisconsin to have an interstate health certificate. *Please check Wisconsin import regulations for exposition if you are coming from MN or MI.* All animals must be enrolled in the Scrapie program. Please have your information ready. If an animal shows signs of illness or infectious disease, including lesions, abscesses (bald or draining), soremouth, ringworm, pinkeye, etc. the entire herd will be barred from the show ring and the fairgrounds. ALL goats will be examined before the start of the show. If there is a question about the health of an animal, a veterinarian will be called at the owner's expense. Please check your animals carefully.
- 8. There will be no pre-show milk out.
- 9. Please provide your own bedding.
- 10. No dogs are allowed in the barns or the show ring area.
- 11. ** Judging will begin on Saturday at 8:00 AM CDT and Sunday at 7:30 AM* * Order of showing is listed on Classes Sheet. All animals must be in place and registered with the show secretary by 7:00 AM. If you must be late, it must be cleared by the show committee before 6:00 AM. Call the Show Chairman at the show site (715-613-9361 or 715-613-9664) for approval. Late arrivals who have not called will not be allowed to show. (NOTE: only situations beyond your control will be accepted.)
- 12. Camping is permitted on the fairgrounds at the following rate: Camping with electric \$17.00 per weekend. Camping without electric \$14.00 per weekend. If you stay anywhere on the fairgrounds, you must pay at the rate indicated.
- 13. The Northern Lights Goat Association and the Central Wisconsin Fair Board, nor any individual associated with these shows will be held responsible for any damages to personal property, accidents, or injuries. A signed release must be included with the registration application.
