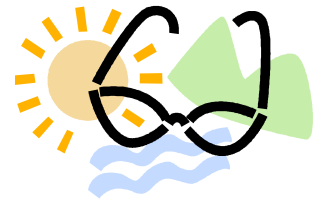

Road Closures To Affect North Renton Residents

The City of Renton will begin construction of the roadway and infrastructure improvements in support of The Landing project beginning in July 2006. The construction will be substantially completed by September 2007. The estimated construction cost of the improvements is approximately \$15 million to \$20 million.

This is a very ambitious time schedule for a project of this magnitude. It is anticipated that the contractor will be working at least 6 days a week, 10 hours a day, with multiple crews working at all times. The detour routings (see page two), and associated savings in contract amount and timing, are all dependent upon a partial closure of Park Avenue North for the

duration of the construction. All streets on the detour routes are classified as either Principal or Minor Arterials on the City's Arterial Street Plan. Construction truck traffic will be required to use existing designated truck routes to access the site. These include Logan Avenue North, Park Avenue North, and North 6th Street between Logan and Park.

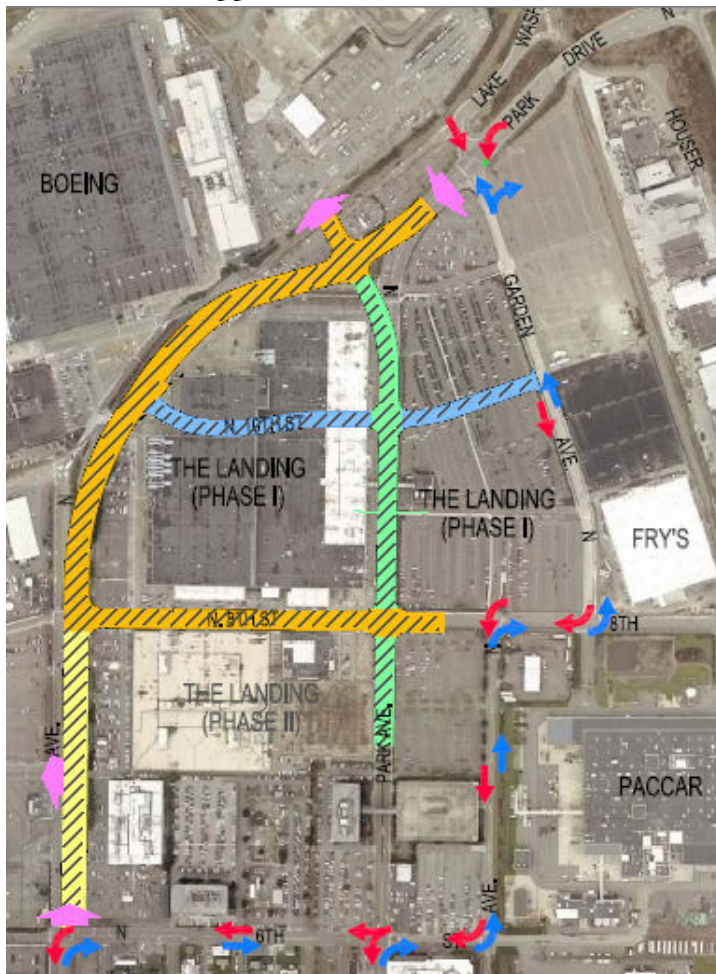

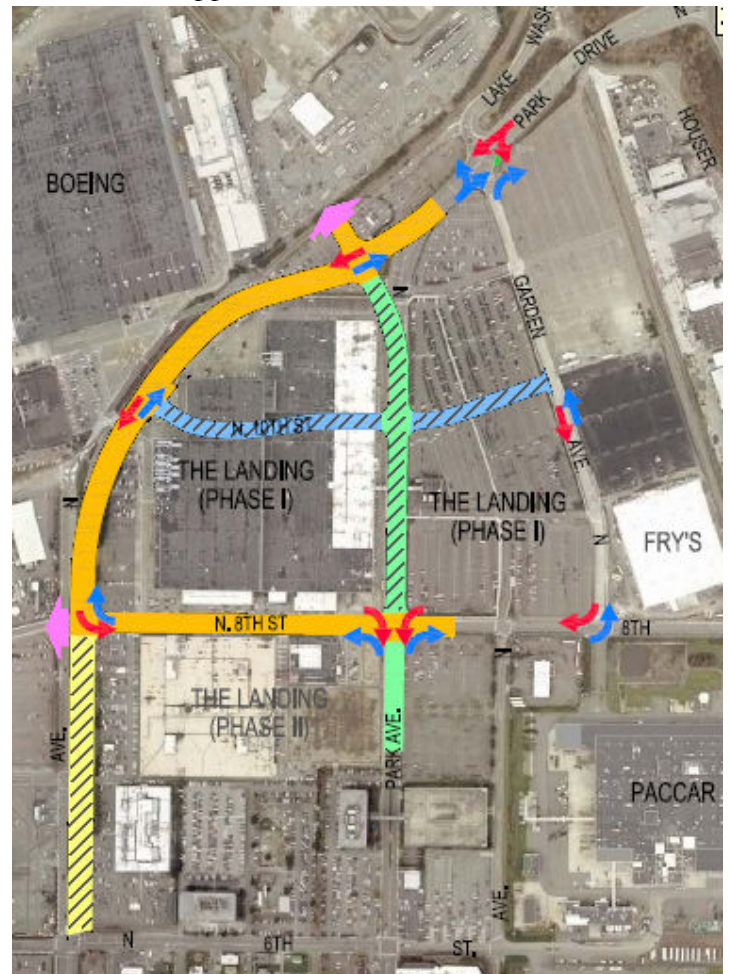
