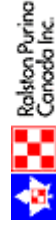

No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee. Phone and telegraphed entries cannot be accepted except in the event of a postal disruption. Email entries will be accepted, but fees **MUST** be paid by the closing date, at the latest.

ATTENTION USA EXHIBITORS

The current rate of exchange favours the US dollar. To take advantage of this, we suggest you purchase Bank Drafts or Money Orders or use your Visa/MasterCard. Personal cheques will be accepted and **MUST** be payable in US funds and for the full amount of the entry. Personally discounted cheques will **NOT** be honoured. Please do NOT mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as such items are not readily cleared through the banks.

TO ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number, but will require an Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. This Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of obtaining points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request to the CKC for an extension.

AS TAKEN FROM CKC HUNT TESTS RULES AND REGULATIONS

Section 18.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a hunt test held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities. The Hunt Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred

TEST INFORMATION

1. Tests will commence at 8:30am.
2. Running order will be determined by a draw; if possible handlers with more than one dog will run in non-consecutive order. We will do our best to avoid conflicts in classes, so please include name of handler.
3. A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN or a PEN number and has completed the requirements for a WC or WCI in accordance with the provisions of these rules may, after closing date and time of entries for a test, be transferred from the WC to the WCI, or from the WCI to the WCX, provided the request for transfer is submitted by the owner, handler or agent to the test secretary in writing prior to the commencement of the test. Please have any request to Dana before 6pm on Saturday or Sunday!
4. Pigeons and/or ducks and/or pheasants and or other game birds will be used on land and ducks in the water. There will be an area for dogs to be introduced to these birds if need be.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in the Hunt Test/WC Tests and must be withdrawn, and are not allowed on the grounds. Entry fees and listing fees will be returned provided that notice in writing is given to the Test Secretary BEFORE the start of the tests.
6. No Confirmations will be sent.
7. Rosettes awarded to all dogs that pass and receive a qualifying score.
8. Lunch will be served for \$6.00 prepaid only (each day)
9. SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED FOR THE WC & HUNT TEST! Make cheques payable to LRCNWO.

11. For the Hunt tests all handlers must wear dark or camouflage clothing (hunting attire) For the WC no white or light clothing allowed.
12. All dogs must be under control at all times.
13. The LRCNWO reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to Canadian Kennel Club rules.
14. Trial locations are difficult to obtain, please respect our borrowed properties.

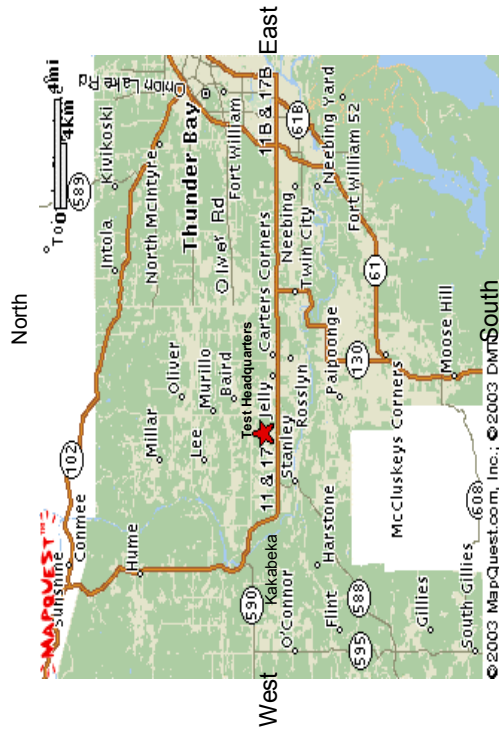
