

## Review of the Past Simple and Past Continuous

### 0) Correction of the homework

#### A) The Past Simple

I) "TO BE": was / were

	Affirmative (+)	Negative (-)	Interrogative
<b>I</b>	I was at school yesterday.	I was not in the café yesterday.	Was I at school yesterday?
<b>He / She / It</b>	He was at school yesterday.	He was not in the café yesterday.	Was he at school yesterday?
<b>We / You / They</b>	We were at school yesterday.	We were not in the café yesterday.	Were we at school yesterday?

S + was / were + ...

S + was / were + ....

Was / Were + S + .....?

II) Regular verbs "watch"

	Affirmative (+)	Negative (-)	Interrogative
<b>I</b>	I watched the news yesterday.	I did not watch the news yesterday.	Did I watch the news yesterday?
<b>He / She / It</b>	He watched the news yesterday.	He did not watch the news yesterday.	Did he watch the news yesterday?
<b>We / You / They</b>	We watched the news yesterday.	We did not watch the news yesterday.	Did we watch the news yesterday?

Verb + ED

DID NOT + Verb

DID + Subject + Verb ...?

- **More regular verbs:** play → played; like → liked; dance → danced.

Study → studied; cry → cried.

- **Uses:**

- **Short action started and finished in the past:** *yesterday, in 2010, last month, last year, 1 hour ago ...*  
ex: Karima travelled to Spain in 2010.

- **With "WHEN" : ex:**

**WHEN** Ali called me yesterday, I was in the bathroom.

I was in the bathroom **WHEN** Ali called me yesterday.

## B) The Past Continuous

l) Review **the present continuous** of “speak”

	<b>Affirmative (+)</b>	<b>Negative (-)</b>	<b>Interrogative</b>
<b>I</b>	I was watching football <u>yesterday at 8 p.m.</u>	I was not watching a film <u>yesterday at 8 p.m.</u>	Was I watching football <u>yesterday at 8 p.m.</u> ?
<b>He / She / It</b>	He was watching football ...	He was not watching a film ...	Was he watching football ...?
<b>We / You / They</b>	We were watching football ...	We were not speaking a film ...	Were we watching football ...?

**Uses:** We use the simple present

- **Long action in the past:**

*Last Monday, Abdesalam was sleeping in the afternoon.*

*Amine and Hamid were playing football yesterday at 6 p.m.*

- **With “WHEN”:**

*When Karim called me on the phone yesterday, I was sleeping. (short action + long action)*

*I was sleeping when Karim called me on the phone yesterday. (long action + short action)*
