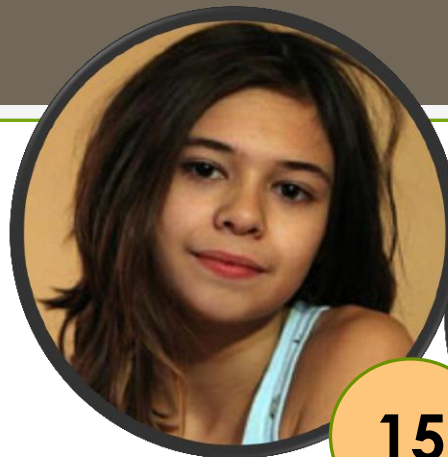

<i>He is 15 years old</i>	<b>He</b> is	<b>He</b> is not
<i>She is 15 years old</i>	<b>She</b> is	<b>She</b> is not
<i>They are twins</i>	<b>They</b> are	<b>They</b> are not
