

## **The Immortal Soul**

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In modern times there has been much controversy regarding the immortality of the Soul of Man, for indeed there are many religions which produce whole books trying to prove from the scriptures and through human logic that Man does not have an immortal soul. The dictionary definition of immortal is something that lasts forever. This may be hard for some to understand for how long is forever. We are told that God always was and always will be, and is everlasting and that He is also immortal. So by this we must accept the fact that, to our minds, God has no ending as far as we can comprehend. Much confusion, we feel, is attributable to a lack of proper definition in the scriptures regarding the parts of Men (subtle bodies) and the structure of the astral that contains the realms of God. Quite often the word spirit is used when it should be soul and vice versa.

Firstly, the Book of Thessalonians (The Bible) tells us that Man is body, spirit and soul, three parts, and we believe that the body is mortal and perishes on death (physical), the spirit is divine which means that although it can exist for millennium of Earth time, it can also eventually dissipate back into the ethers from whence it came, and the soul is immortal or indestructible. The Bible says that on physical death the soul of Man goes back to God from whence it came. If the soul is of God, is made from God, and returns to God which is immortal, so we are told, then is the soul also immortal?

Take the instance of Jesus Christ. He was born of woman conceived of Man and became a living Soul. He was crucified and died. Then He ascended into Heaven where He sits at the right hand of Jehovah forever, so surely this alone indicates some form of immortality. Jesus was seen in the Garden of Gethsemane as a spirit by Mary, and this Earth-bound spirit of Jesus said to Mary, Touch me not, for I have not yet ascended unto My Father in Heaven. This was just two days after His death. Now, many churches claim that as soon as one passes away, they go into a state of unconsciousness and their souls return to God until the Resurrection, and that it is at this time that all souls are awakened to face the Judgement of God. Well,

this did not happen to Jesus for He was certainly awake when He spoke to Mary, Then He went to His Father in Heaven and then returned in an immortalised body and roamed the Earth, talking and walking, eating and drinking with people. We are told that what happened to Him is also our heritage if we remain true and faithful unto God Jehovah, as He was the first and showed us the way and the path to Salvation.

Another point to consider is the passage in Matthew that tells us that during the first three days after His death, He descended to the nether realms (Hell, Hades, or whatever) to preach to the disobedient spirits and unsaved souls so that they may have a chance at redemption. Who were these souls and how many were there? Twenty, one thousand or a billion? If they had once lived and should now be unconscious what was the use of Jesus preaching to a whole multitude of people who would not hear Him? These souls could not have been the minions of Satan who had been cast down by Jehovah for their wickedness, for we know that these beings have been denied the flesh and so they did not live on the Earth plane at any time, and for them there is no redemption, so this would be an act of folly to preach to those who had no chance of Salvation or progression.

The process of the soul-spirit unit is formulated thus: when Man and all the animal kingdom were created (evolved under God's guiding influence), each had a physical body and a spirit. Next we get the spirits of God and one third of these were cast out with Satan. The remaining spirits were then able to transfuse themselves with the spirit of Man (about 80,000 years ago) and the result of this uniting of the spirits (God and Man's) resulted in the creation of the Soul.

At this point the spirit of Man became a Divine Spirit whose purpose from then on was to accompany the soul in its many incarnations as it travelled onwards and ever upwards on a path of Celestial progression until its perfection allows it to reign in the realm of Jehovah forever in immortality. When this goal is reached, the Divine Spirit of Man passes away into astral matter as it has served its purpose and it is the reference to this that many misconstrue often by believing that this is the destruction of the Soul. On death the spirit and the soul leave the body over a period of three

days, and then they separate, the Soul going back to God and the Divine Spirit remaining in the middle astral realms awaiting its next incarnation.

It is interesting to note (according to Spirit) that when the Divine Soul is born again into another life, it leaves behind an etheric record of its past existences as a memorial. This is why it is possible to find out about past lives and the like. The Bible says that with Adam came mortal death and with Christ came immortal life. This was because of the fall of Man through Man's sin for God had meant for Adam and his progeny were to exist in the Garden of Eden forever (immortally). There are some groups who claim that the immortality comes only after the second judgement and that Man is more or less on probation for a period after the resurrection and the first judgement, but this, according to the scriptures, is illogical for it says that those who were cast out and the wicked souls (those who had lived Earth lives) were cast into a lake of fire where they dwelled forever (immortally) and this is after the first resurrection and judgement so there could be no truth in this claim and is just another misconception.

When conception takes place in the human species, the fertilized ovum starts to develop and it is the physical body and the spirit of Man. Then, at about the twelfth week, the foetus is quickened by the Divine Spirit and, finally at the moment of birth (as soon as the umbilical cord is cut), the Soul enters the baby and we have another living Soul. We get many statements that relate to immortality. Some say that the Soul of Man may dwell in the House of the Lord forever. This, we think, indicates immortality.

The Holy Bible is full of paradoxes and mysteries owing to mistranslations and religious interference, and much research is needed to fully understand it for, at times if we take it literally, it seems to almost contradict its own works. For example, the anti-reincarnationists always quote the scripture which says, Man is born only once and dies once only. But just what type of death does this refer to, as there are several types of death. If that scripture means physical death, then we have a problem because many people in the Bible died and were raised from the dead and then died again. This was so in the case of Lazarus, but this also occurs in modern times in hospitals where a patient has been pronounced as clinically dead and then

has come back to life and lived for many years after this. Then we get some people who don't die at all, and this was the case with Elijah who was uplifted to Heaven, so as to not taste death, so says the Good Book. So here we have some definite contradictions.

Could this scripture be referring to the birth of the Divine Spirit of Man and his final demise after a life of incarnations. As psychic researchers we know that the dead are awake after their spirit-soul unit leaves their earthly body, some not immediately of course for this awakening depends on the type of death one suffers and one's belief systems, for it seems that we tend to inherit what we believe. Once death overtakes us, the first awakening can herald all sorts of strange things until the light and love of the other spirit beings around us and the prayers from our loved ones still on the Earth plane break through this barrier of ignorance that blinds us as to our true whereabouts. If we believe that on death there is nothing, only blackness to greet us, then that is what we first experience. A knowledge of life after death is very important to all mortals in order to guarantee peace and happiness on their awakening behind the veil.

Jesus Christ and three of the Apostles saw the Divine Spirits of Moses and Elijah, and Jesus conversed with them. They could not have been in an unconscious state. The Divine Spirit of Elijah came back again as John the Baptist, so said Jesus. Many of us in our own group plus countless thousands of other psychic people have received messages of love and comfort from the conscious spirits of those who have passed over into death. Some use the scriptures that say the dead cannot speak to prove that all psychics are being hoodwinked by Satan and his followers. Now, in respect to speaking with the dead, we can say categorically that we do not know personally of any reputable psychic who does this.

However, the author and most others he knows receive the communication in the mind by spiritual inspiration in the form of pictures or words that appear and we liken this action unto the incident that occurred and is recorded in the New Testament when Peter the Apostle wanted to know what types of food the people should eat, and it says that the Lord caused a blind to appear in his mind or the air which only he

could see and the answers were clearly written there for him to understand. This is how all of us function with our work in a like manner. So, if we are evil, where did Peter stand on this matter. Most of the condemnation we receive is from people who have never had a true spiritual illumination or are devoid of any extra-sensitivity. It is these people with their fears, their subconscious prejudices and lack of understanding of the Mystic Christ who preach the loudest and the longest, and, in doing this, are demeaning the manifest power of Jehovah and the Holy Spirit.

Many of the groups who don't believe in the immortal soul concept also don't believe that Jesus was totally physically restored when resurrected, that He borrowed another body in which He cavorted about after the crucifixion. To us, this would indicate possession which would be wrong to start of with. Some say He made up another body to walk about in and that this is why no one recognised Him in His glorified state. But we say, why go to all this bother, especially when He had a perfectly good body of His own that had hardly gone cold. Not only this but His own body would have been more realistic for it would have shown the marks and wounds of His sufferings, whereas on a borrowed body He would have to cause such things to appear. So, in point of fact, if Jesus was fully resurrected (totally restored in His own body) then there would be no bones to find for all HIS flesh and bone had been immortalised and glorified for it was to return to the Father where He awaits until the second coming.

If there were no remnants of the body of Jesus left, then what are the relics that are reputed to be interred in certain places? This is anybody's guess, but if we believe the scriptures, these bones cannot belong to Our Lord. Some religionists say that the Immortal soul was invented by the Catholics so that they would have something to barter with that could give the Church a pecuniary advantage, meaning that if you paid the priests enough money, they would say enough prayers to buy your soul, or that of a relative, out of Hell. There is no doubt, according to historical records, that such things were practiced for monetary gain, but the evidence of the Immortal Soul was around long before the advent of the Catholics. In fact, the immortality of the Soul was almost a universal belief amongst all nations, no matter how primitive, so we could reason that this was the spirit of God coming to all men in all times, and

giving them some indication of their eternal existence in the realm of the spirit.

The Australian Aboriginal understand the simple concept of the triunity of Man (body, spirit, and soul) and all of the Polynesian people spoke of this in their legends and in their carvings. So did all of the tribes of South America and we can hardly call these early civilizations Catholics.

The passage in the Old Testament that refers to the Sons of God who came down and bred with the daughters of Man indicates that these beings were without souls because they were not the products of this world and were more than likely from another dimension. However, though they were not subject to Earth Karma, the offspring that they produced with the Earth beings became living Souls. It is believed by many esoteric researchers that all of the outer space colonists that came to the planet Earth to help populate it and introduce new races were all without souls, and that this planet has a unique feature about it and that is that the essence of God and the Divine Spirit of Man produces a soul that has the power to progress and purify itself into a form of celestial matter and be able to voyage into infinity. Adam who was made a living soul had no karma to fulfil as he had not existed before. Jesus was made in a like manner and was without sin for He had never lived on the Earth plane before so He only had one physical birth and one death.

Through spirit revelation we are told that the original inhabitants of this Earth (These are those who have never intermingled with the blood of races from other dimensions) only ever reincarnate back into the Earth plane, but those who are the progeny of the daughters of Man and the Sons of outer space often go back to their own or other dimensions for rebirth. For example, the author, who is a product of two worlds, was told that, to date, he has had thirteen Earth incarnations and eleven incarnations in other dimensions. It appears that to live a life on the Earth plane is considered to be a mighty challenge by other extra-terrestrials, but very fulfilling and invaluable if one does not succumb and is able to rise above the animalistic tendencies that pervade the Soul, so one sees the Earth experience as one would seek a higher leaving certificate or being able to gain a degree of higher learning.

Perhaps the extra-terrestrials like to add to their glory by displaying a diploma from the University of Adversity on Earth as a reference to help them attain a higher status in their own existence. Who knows? One thing is for sure and that is that there are a whole host of riddles and mysteries about Man's origin and destiny that have yet to be learned through research and revelation and many of the keys to this knowledge are hidden in myths and legends within the Bible and other historical works everything else. As far as basic matter is concerned in the Universe appears to be immortal, and, as Man and his dimension is created from this space dust shaped by God force, then why should not Man have a part of himself that was also immortal.

The subtle body of Man is believed to hold forty nine minor chakra points and that each of these points represents a lesson to be learned that will enable the soul to come to perfection. Seven times seven equals forty nine. Once again we see the magic of numbers and how they relate to our eternal destiny, if only one lesson can be learned in one lifetime, then this would indicate forty nine lives to live to reach Paradise. However, the guides tell us that it is possible to learn two lessons in one lifetime so this could shorten the rebirth factor in the lives of some. All of this -is purely hypothesis as far as we are concerned, but hypothesis is the scaffolding that one erects around a project that is under investigation. It can be torn down and reerected time and time again until the project is resolved. If the mind is closed, then the comprehension is limited and, in this type of study, all things are possible when studying the mysteries of all creation.

One of the most delightful aspects of the journey of the soul is that many of these units join up and become soul mates and quite often re-incarnate together in pairs or groups with inter-changing roles in each different life and there is an eternal bond between these units.

In many different types of books we read that quite a number of people reincarnate almost immediately after their last life, but our sources say that this is not so and that the earliest that some are reborn is just over 199 years, some between 150 and 180 years, and that the main body seem to reappear about every 500 years and

upwards. So, one often wonders about the stories of reincarnation in places like India and Sri Lanka where some child claims that she remembers her last life, which in most cases was only a few years previously, in most cases we don't believe that the person has been born again and that it is only a familiar spirit from another deceased person who is earth bound and is supplying the information to the other person through their super-conscious. This type of phenomenon is rampant amongst these similar races of people for their belief system is endowed with this wrong conception of re-incarnation that only tends to further confuse the issue.

The Apostle Paul referred to the immortality of the Soul on many occasions. Some of these references can be found in the Book of Romans. 2:7, and in Corinthians 15:53, and when referring to the life hereafter, he (Paul) said, If there be no divinity to Man's soul in a life hereafter, then let us eat, drink and be merry for tomorrow we die. Furthermore we should add, we are no more, so let us live it up now while we are here in this one life. This action, of course, is folly and we believe that Christianity without re-incarnation holds no promise for Mankind, and that if all people knew that they were creating the destiny of their next life to come while they are living this life, then they would be more concerned about their thoughts and behaviour.

We are told from the spirit that while we exist in this life, we are manufacturing the tabernacle (body) for our next life. It is the karma we are building up, either bad or good, that will determine the type of lifestyle that we will experience in that next life. Somewhere in this world there is information and proof of the visits from galactic beings that arrived here and merged with the environment and with the people, and this evidence is hidden either in caves, under the ground or beneath the sea, but, in time, it will be found and then we will understand where such primitive peoples that existed 50,000 years ago suddenly were in possession of knowledge far in advance of their own intellectual development at that time. science, metallurgy, agriculture, mathematics and writing all of a sudden came into existence and these primitive people were able to build architectural edifices that were marvels and many of these still stand in part to this day. In fact, many of their methods of construction. almost defy explanation, so we see that the sons of God and their progeny were certainly

supermen in the eyes of the local yokels.

There is a scripture that says, and the Lord shall come to judge the living and the dead. Many use this phrase to support the idea that once dead, you are not conscious until the Judgement Day. But, it does not mean this, for the dead are physically non-existent any more but are still alive in the spirit and quite aware of what is going on around them and what is happening in this world as well. The souls cry out in anguish as they look down upon the folly of Mankind. Then there is a section in the Bible which says that on the great Day of Judgement the sea shall give up its dead, the earth shall give up its dead. Many believe that there will be a physical recreation of all those who once lived. But, why should God go to all this bother when the spirits of all those who have once lived still exist with a full knowledge of all that has happened to them. In any case, we are told to fear not concerning the death of the physical. life, but only worry about the death of the Soul, so this is what will be judged by God, the soul not the physical body, for the flesh is a corrupt substance, and that which is corrupt cannot enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

However, the spirit of all Mankind will already be there after death ready for this graduation ceremony into the different levels of the Astral Realms, for there are degrees of Glory which one will inherit according to one's faithfulness and service to Jehovah. This description of the upliftment of the dead is purely a metaphorical summary of what people can expect and addressed to them in this manner in those times.

It is obvious that there are two judgements, one at the completion of every life we live, and this is the karma of our next existence, and the final great judgement of the souls after all the incarnations have been completed. This is why we suffer reward and punishment in each life, for it says, Judge not lest ye be judged. So the action is in the immediate, not in a million years when God gets around to it.

The development of the soul is like the growth of a child, and you don't wait until the child has become an adult and is staggering with old age before you start to correct it. Reproof and chastisement for erring are administered along the way and this gives

the person a chance to get back onto the straight and narrow and the same applies to soul growth, for sometimes a person has to relive an experience again in another existence because the lesson that had to be learned was not completed. After all, if we are allowed to resit an examination again in this world that we failed, surely our God in His great wisdom and parental love for us will give our soul another chance to redeem itself. Furthermore, if after all our lifetimes of growth and experience we still can't make the grade, then no one can blame God for He has certainly given us many chances.

Overall we feel that people who contend and split hairs over the difference between Divine and Immortal are playing at pedantics for, even if the human soul only lives for 250~000 years, this against a mere three score years and ten of Earth life surely must seem an eternity. To deny the immortality of the soul of Man is to deny the eternity of God and in this day and age the demeaning of God and Christ seem to be the in thing. Most of this is done by avante garde scholars who deny the immaculate conception, the total resurrection and try to explain away miracles according to Man's limited intelligence and understanding of the eternal and the infinite. There are even those who claim that Jesus did not even exist and was a composite personality created by the early Fathers of the Catholic Church. This belief even robs Christ of His immortality also.

Modern day quantum physics shows us that it is possible for something from nothing to appear, and that something can return to nothing, In thinking about this modern day theory of the Big Bang concept, we think of these opening lines in Genesis, In the beginning there was only a void, and the God Jehovah spoke and the creation started. Finally we say that, if after billions and trillions of years everything goes back to the void, then on this premise perhaps the soul of Man is not immortal after all, only divine, but this question can only be answered if there is an end of time.
