

Who Was Judas Iscariot?

Who Were The Twelve Apostles?

As reincarnationists we have often wondered who were the 12 Apostles in previous lives and was there any significance about their birth at the same time as Jesus Christ. For many years the author has used the scriptures in the New Testament which says that John the Baptist was the spirit of Elias (Elijah) born again and indeed in previous manuscripts has written this down as being so. However it must be remembered that this was not because of any spirit but based on a statement from the Bible.

One day during a meditation period the author was told by the guides that Elijah a prophet from the Old Testament who was alleged to have escaped death by ascending unto the heavens in a flaming chariot was only born once on this Earth plane, did not reincarnate again, and his Soul went off into another dimension of existence in some other Galaxy.

The author then began to wonder that if this was true who was it that appeared to Jesus, Peter, James and John on the mountain top as described in Mathew chapter 17 verse 3. If Elijah had indeed moved out of our dimension, did he come back at that time to be with (loses at the "transfiguration" of Jesus? So who was John the Baptist?
