# What is Curriculum ?

It is a process where -

- Setting of objectives/ goals, identification of learning Knowledge, skills
- Identification or selection of methods, materials and
- Setting of monitoring/ evaluation procedure

# Example of Training Curriculum

- Objectives of Enumerators training:

By the end of the training trainees will be able to - Use tools (Properly, Individually)

- Example of Training Programmes
  - Learning Objectives (1,2,3...)
  - Subject/ Topic (1,2,3...)
  - Time (1,2,3...)
  - Training Method (1,2,3...)
  - Training Materials (1,2,3...)

# Example Training Curriculum

- Name of Training: Enumerators Training
- Target group/ Level: AHW/ANM or ...
- Number of Participants: 15
- Training period: 7 days (42 hours)
- Goal of Training: To strengthen HIP by assessment

# Example Training Curriculum

- Learning Objectives : Be able to fill the tools
- Subject/ Topic: House Hold Survey tool (HH)
- Time: 4 Hours
- Training Method : Mini Lecture, Question Answer, Group work, Coaching etc.
- Training Materials: OHP, Transparencies, News print, Markers, White Board, etc
- Learning Materials: Guidelines, Tools etc.

# What is Lesson Plan

- A road map of conducting a learning programme. It is proposed plan which ensures to meet the learning objectives.
- Lesson Plan
  - Prepares trainer ready
  - Systemic preparation and proceedings
  - Planning of resources

# Characteristics of Lesson Plan

- Written details/ documents
- Guidelines to conduct the session
- Specific Subject matter
- Plan with a Serial flow

# Elements of Lesson Plan

- Setting of Objectives
- Describe target groups
- Subject/ Content/ Points
- Time Table
- Methods/ materials
- Role of Participants
- Plan of Evaluation

# Principles of Lesson Plan

- Simple to Complex
- Known to Unknown
- Create Learning environment
- Discuss on the objective of learning
- Bridging
- Outline of contents of the session
- Presentation (serial/ systemic)

- Active participation of participants
- Making Summary/ Ask for feed backs
- Evaluation of the session
- Inspire for practical / Practice
