Notes:

1. Cadets are to ensure that they have clothing appropriate for the Display Team practices. Belly shirts are not to be worn. Clothing must be clean and in good condition. T-shirts with offensive language or graphics will not be worn. Trousers will be worn around the waist and secured with a belt and **not** worn down around the hips.
2. Grey wool socks **MUST** be worn when in uniform. For those allergic to wool, alternate grey socks (polyester or cotton) can be worn, or cotton socks can be worn under the grey wool socks.
3. Cadet boots and sneakers will be worn during practices (even when out-of-uniform). Cadets should ensure that the boots and sneakers are well worked in and fit properly. If at all possible, cadets should try to arrange for a second pair of "practice" boots.

Notes Cont'd:

4. Sea Cadets MUST have the black tunic belt.
5. Cadets are required to travel to and from Tattoo in Uniform.
6. Cadets are to arrive with a proper haircut.
7. Cadets must have the permission of a parent/guardian to use in-line skates or skateboards (as noted on the permission slip).
8. Washing machines and dryers will be available for cadets to use. These are coin operated.
9. Those cadets continuing on to camp should ensure that they either:
 - a. arrange to have any extra kit needed for the summer course dropped off to them before the end of the Tattoo; or
 - b. bring with them the kit required for the Tattoo and their summer course.
10. Cadets will need some spending money during the three weeks they are part of the Nova Scotia international Tattoo. Most of the money will be needed for incidentals such as toiletries and haircuts, pizza during pizza night(s), movie night, mall day (shopping), and Tattoo items: yearbook, pictures and other Tattoo memorabilia cadets may wish to purchase. With this in mind, cadets and parents should budget accordingly. Cadets will be responsible for keeping track of and safeguarding their own money.
11. Cadets may bring cell phones and/or other personal communication devices but they must be passed in to the Duty Officer each night prior to light's out. These items will be returned each morning to the cadet.
12. During the course of the 3 weeks there will be a number of "Theme" days. Cadets should bring the appropriate clothing as follows to participate in these events:
 - crazy/ funky sock day
 - red and white day for Canada Day
 - element day - everyone wears something to show their element (Sea, Army or Air) such as a colour or picture on their t-shirt, a pin, etc.
 - plaid and stripe day
 - ugly necktie day
 - bright/neon day

*Things **NOT** to bring (nor to be purchased while at the Tattoo):*

1. Knives
2. Incense
3. Candles
4. Matches *or* Lighters
5. Cigarettes
6. Alcohol
7. Banned substances
8. Appliances (Toasters, etc.)
9. TV/VCR
10. Video Game Systems/PCs
11. Water Pistols/Guns
12. Laser Pointers
13. Ceremonial Web Gear (Belts or Gloves)
14. Skate Boards
15. In-line Skates
