- Our show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and their rules shall govern.
- **Show order: Showmanship, Combined Jr/Sr Doe shows, Junior Doe shows**
- The Combined Jr/Sr Doe Shows are sanctioned for Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Toggenburg, AOP, and Recorded Grade. The Junior and Senior shows are not separately sanctioned.
- The Junior Doe Show is sanctioned for Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Toggenburg, AOP, and Recorded Grade.
- Cash premiums paid to all Best of Breeds and Junior Champions
- Substitutions allowed within the same breed sanction. No refunds.
- Base date for computing age is June 20, 2009.
- Only the original registration for animals six months or older will be accepted. A stamped duplicate will be accepted for animals less than six months of age.
- Health check will be done prior to penning, and the decision is final.
- Exhibitors are required to clean out all pens used by them during the show and take manure and bedding out to manure spreader in show area before they are allowed to leave.
- Smoking in designated areas only.
- There will be a raffle table and we appreciate any and all donations. Please help support our show by participating in our raffle.
- Spaces available for vendors of goat-related items at no charge. Donations to raffle table appreciated.
- Exhibitors can arrive Friday night. Camping space available at no charge. No hookups available.
- All animals must be in place by 8:30 a.m.
- Pen space limited. Portable pens encouraged. ***Free breakfast to anyone bringing their own pens!***
- Breakfast and lunch will be offered at a reasonable cost, proceeds go to Heritage Farm.
- Youth Showmanship will be judged by the Danish system. Sign up any time before the start of classes. Cash awards generously provided by Bob and Elaine Bartlett. Novice: Under 8 years old, Junior: 8-13 years old, Senior: 14-19 years old.
- Master Youth Showperson: first place winners from the three age groups compete.
- No entry fee for Showmanship Classes.
- **Showmanship Clinic and Bonfire Friday evening, starting around 7:00 p.m.**
