A HUNTER PACE is a cross-country ride with a partner over a marked and timed course. It will include 2-3' jumps; riders may go over OR around all fences. The distance is between 8 and 9 miles. The perfect time is predetermined by the officials, and the winning pair will be that pair which completes the course closest to the perfect "fox-hunting" time. Those of you who do not wish to compete for time please indicate on the entry form and you will be started after the competitors.

TEAMS of 2-3 will be limited to a time of go between 8:00 - 11 AM. Be on time; unfortunately, if you miss your time of go, due to large number of entries we cannot guarantee you another starting opportunity. Indicate on entry your preferred time of go & we will try to accommodate you.

ENTRY FEE: \$40 per rider includes lunch. Pony Clubbers \$30. Your entry will not be guaranteed unless accompanied by entry fee, which must be received by Sept. 20. **Negative coggins and rabies** within 12 months required with entry. DIRECTIONS: From I-95 South-Exit,70, at the end of ramp, go straight 1/4 mile to Tee; turn right on Rt. 156 North; go 2.6 miles; Lord Creek Farm on left.
From I-95 North: Exit 70; at end of ramp go left onto Rt. 156N; go 2.6 miles; farm on left.
From Rt. 11 South to Rt. 82 West, go south on Route 156 for 6 miles, farm on right.

SAFETY RULES

1. Horses must be sound: all equipment must be in good repair.
2. Safety helmet and shoes with heel required: chin strap required for those under 18 years old.
3. A safety check will be made prior to the ride. If tack and mount are considered unsafe entry fee will be refunded.
4. No minor child may be left on the grounds unattended.
5. A warm up area will be provided.
6. Red arrows on yellow or white background will mark the direction of the ride.
FOR SAFETY REASONS, DO NOT RIDE OFF MARKED TRAILS.
7. Please do not bring pets.
8. Please rebuild any jump you might knock down because a fallen jump can be very dangerous for those who are still to come.
