Class Fees and Awards

Individual Class: \$15
Armband Eq \$15
Division of 3 Classes: \$40
Team Competition: \$20 per Team
(See separate Entry Form for Rules)

Late Fee: \$10 late fee imposed for all entries received after April 30th.

Ribbons through 8th place to be awarded in each class.
Championship and Reserve Championship will be awarded in both
Open and JR/AM sections of each division.

Refunds must be requested in writing on Add/Scratch form at
Secretary's desk. Request must be received prior to start of class.

First Class in each Ring begins promptly at 8AM. See Tentative
Schedule for ring assignments.

Attire: Casual, informal or formal attire.

Courses: Courses may consist of any combination of the following: brush,
gates, planks, oxers, post & rails, coops, and walls. Ditches, banks and water
will not be included.

Ties: Ties involving first place shall be jumped off. For all other ties, time
taken to complete the first round will decide, unless otherwise stated.

Championships: Champion and reserve will be awarded to the two horses
scoring the most points in the stated classes in each division.

Rules & Regulations:

1. Every class offered herein will be run in accordance with the stated
AHSA rule table.
2. All riders **MUST** wear protective, properly fitting headgear while
mounted on any horse anywhere on the Show Grounds. USPC requires that
riders wear ASTM/SEI rated helmets at USPC events. It is strongly
suggested that all riders comply with this rule.
3. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of show
management, but Litchfield Pony Club will in no way be responsible for any
loss, accident, or damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of entry
that each exhibitor, spectator, trainer and attendant hold Litchfield Pony Club
and its members and agents harmless for any loss or damage that may occur
to persons, animals or property.
4. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide any classes
if in its opinion the entries so warrant.
5. Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to each class.
6. Junior/Amateur & Open classes will be run concurrently.
7. Adds, scratches and changes must be made in writing on form available
at Show Secretary's desk prior to the start of the class.
8. All dogs must be on leashes.

Junior: An individual who has not reached his/her 18th birthday as of
December 1st of the
current competition year.

Amateur: See Article 808 in USAEq rulebook for definition.

Open: All individuals with no specific qualifications for the rider.

USAEq Rules Cited:

Timed First Jump Off Classes: *Table II, 2(b):* Knockdown Classes. Classes scored on Faults and Time. If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, he continues without leaving the ring, after a signal to jump the jump-off course.

Power & Speed Classes: *Table II, 2(c):* If a competitor has gone clean in first round (power portion of course) he will (without stopping or circling) immediately begin the jump off-course (speed portion of course).

Gambler's Choice: *Table II, 4:* Scored on faults and time, with choice of course.
