IMPORTANT NOTE TO COMPETITORS

Unlike past years, helmet checks will take place immediately after the Competitor's Briefing. Therefore, please BRING YOUR HELMET WITH YOU TO THE BRIEFING.

Also note: while it is not a rule that hair may not be worn done up or pushed up under the helmet, it is an undesirable practice for a number of reasons. The most important is that if the helmet fits with the hair under it, it will be too loose if the hair either comes loose or is worn down. Competitors are reminded that the helmet must fit properly for all phases, including formal inspection as well as all riding phases. Regardless of how well a helmet may fit at formal inspection, competitors are NEVER permitted to ride with a helmet that does not fit correctly.
