You have been accepted to attend the ICFA2001 Instrumentation School with financial support.

The National Science Foundation in the U.S. will provide a return air ticket that will be made available at the specific airline counter at the airport from which you will travel.

If you intend attending, please send an email of acceptance to the organizing committee (icfa2001@nac.ac.za) with a copy to Dr M Sheaff (sheaff@fnal.gov) as soon as possible indicating that you accept the invitation to participate and plan to be at the school for the full two weeks. This is essential in order to arrange the airplane ticket. We will assume that you want to arrive in Cape Town on Sunday, the 25th of March, and leave either Friday afternoon, the 6th of April, or Saturday morning, the 7th. If you plan to stay longer at your own expense you should indicate this clearly in your email of acceptance. Please also indicate which city you plan to fly from (and back to).

Your accommodation and meals in South Africa will be taken care of by the local organizing committee. Please fill in the registration form that is available on our web page in order to facilitate our arrangements.

You will be responsible for obtaining a visa to visit South Africa. We are checking the visa requirements and will also send a letter of invitation to participate in the conference that can accompany your application. In order to pick up the ticket, you need to have the visa. The letter can be used to get the visa since you will not have the ticket to use for this purpose.

We are looking forward to seeing you in Cape Town.
