



**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Sharon Barbee—Modifications by US Design Team

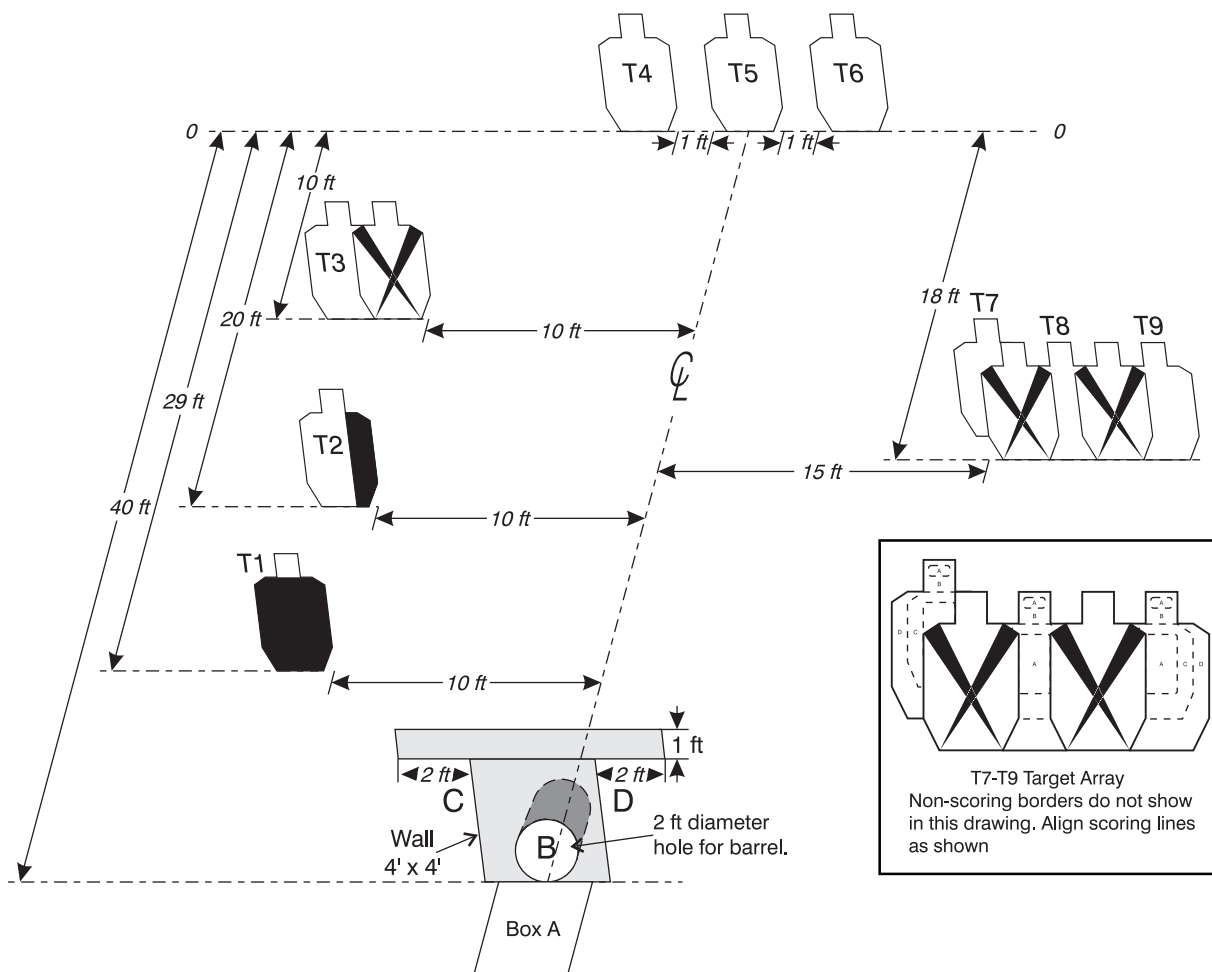
**START POSITION:** Standing in front of barrel facing to the left or right, toes of both feet touching side of Box A, looking uprange, both wrists above respective shoulders.

**STAGE PROCEDURE**

Upon start signal, from Box A, engage only T1-T3 from position C underneath the bar. Make a mandatory reload and engage only T4-T6 through Barrel B. Make another mandatory reload and from Box A, engage only T7-T9 from position D underneath the bar. Competitor may engage the arrays in any order and there is no penalty for faulting Box A while shooting through Barrel B.

**SCORING**

**SCORING:** Comstock, 18 rounds, 90 points  
**TARGETS:** 9 IPSC  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2/paper  
**START - STOP:** Audible - Last Shot  
**PENALTIES:** Per current edition of USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.  
 Failure to perform the mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



**SETUP NOTES:** Scoring perforation of no-shoot at T3 overlays A-zone scoring line. LEFT scoring line of no-shoot at T7 overlays LEFT A-zone scoring line, and top B-zone line of no-shoot lines up with lower B-zone line of T7. All other no-shoot scoring lines overlay A-



zone scoring lines. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet. The barrel at position B is 2 feet in diameter. Set target height of T1, T2, T3 and T7 to 4 feet high at shoulders. Set T4, T5 and T6 to 3 feet high at shoulders.
