The next meeting of the OLP Quilters will be on Tuesday, July 12th at 9:30 am, in the parish center. Everyone is welcome.



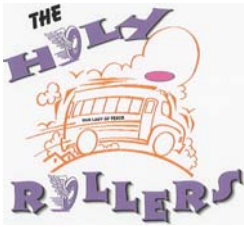
