Dear Folks,

We have been in the process of trying to get a Youth Group up and running again for some time. Kristy Wind who has been coordinating the Vacation Bible School for several years has got the ball rolling. This summer she invited 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> graders to participate in a Youth Camp Outing at Spring Brook State Park. On the weekend of August 5, 6 and 7, 15 young people from our parish went on a camping trip along with several parents and adult supervisors. The Youth Group had a grand time camping, swimming, hiking, building fires, playing, telling stories, singing, praying, sharing, eating and eating (did I mention eating!). The weather was great and so was the experience. There are pictures of their adventure in the narthex.

This was a great start to a new Youth Group. Other activities will be planned through out the year. Keep an eye on the bulletin for up-coming events. Kristy Wind will also represent the youth of the parish on the Parish Council replacing Miles Sweeney who is off the University of Buffalo.

The Corn Roast sponsored by the Holy Name Society went off with out a hitch last Saturday night. The weather was fantastic with the exception of the three minutes it rained as the German American Band was setting up. That was just enough rain to drive the band into the Parish Hall. In spite of it all the band played on! There were speakers placed out side

so that everyone could enjoy the music. The air-conditioning inside drew a good crowd for those who wanted to escape the summer heat and humidity.

The Holy Name Society even purchased and put up a tent to provide shade for the workers and keep the fires dry in the event of rain. There was a movement started to build an outdoor open air picnic pavilion behind the parish center. It could be used for the Corn Roast next year and it would also come in handy for the Religious Education Program, Vacation Bible School, and provide picnic space for other Church related activities. The feeling was that there was enough talent among the parishioners to provide the 'sweat equity' to build it. If that proves to be true between the Holy Name Society and the Parish we could come up with the funds to finance the project. 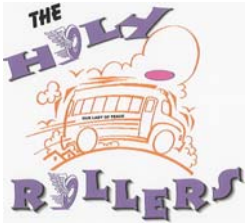
**I GOT IT!**
