Omega Alpha Announces “Change for Change” Campaign

In an effort to support the educational enhancement of our community, the annual Book Scholarship was established to assist local high school students from the chapter’s current philanthropy. This year’s chapter philanthropy is ELECT/CTC (Education Leading to Employment and Career Training/Cradle

The Classroom). The main focus of ELECT/CTC is to keep pregnant and parent teens in school and to help them graduate from high school. Book Scholarship applications have been distributed to local Kensington, Olney, Mastbaum and Thomas Edison High Schools.
