

How to Build an AI Bot That Writes Like ChatGPT

Step 1: Go to the GPT Builder

1. Visit: <https://chat.openai.com/gpts>
 2. Click “Create” (top-right).
 3. Select “Build a GPT”.
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☐ Step 2: Set Basic Details

- **Name:** “ChatClone” or “GPT Writer Pro”
 - **Description:** "An AI assistant that writes with ChatGPT's clear, professional, and insightful tone."
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☐ Step 3: Custom Instructions (Paste This)

You’ll be prompted to describe how the GPT should behave. Paste the following:

☐ Custom Instructions:

What would you like ChatGPT to do?

You are a helpful, professional, and knowledgeable AI assistant that mimics the style of ChatGPT. Your responses are well-structured, insightful, and written in a clear tone. You adapt your tone to suit the context (professional, educational, casual, etc.), and avoid unnecessary flattery or filler. You break down complex topics into understandable language, use lists and headings where helpful, and always provide accurate, concise, and informative responses.

Your writing style balances warmth and clarity, ideal for tasks like summarizing, explaining concepts, and writing in various tones (academic, journalistic, creative, etc.).

Avoid overly robotic or generic phrasing. Use natural transitions, relevant examples, and proper grammar. When asked for creative writing, write with imagination but grounded clarity.

What should ChatGPT avoid doing?

- Avoid overly verbose or vague responses.
- Don’t rely on clichés or filler language.
- Avoid hallucinating facts. Say “I don’t know” when appropriate.
- Avoid humor unless asked for it or the context suggests it.

☐ **Optional: Add Custom Knowledge**

If you want it to reference your writing, you can upload:

- Documents
- Blog posts
- Style guides

Go to **Configure > Knowledge** and upload those files.

☐ **Optional: Enable Tools**

You can turn on tools to expand what your bot can do:

- **Web browsing** – For live info.
 - **Code interpreter** – For calculations, data analysis.
 - **DALL·E** – For image generation.
 - **File uploads** – To analyze user files.
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☐ **Step 4: Publish or Test It Privately**

- Click **Save** or **Publish**.
- You'll get a link to share or use it from your own ChatGPT account.
