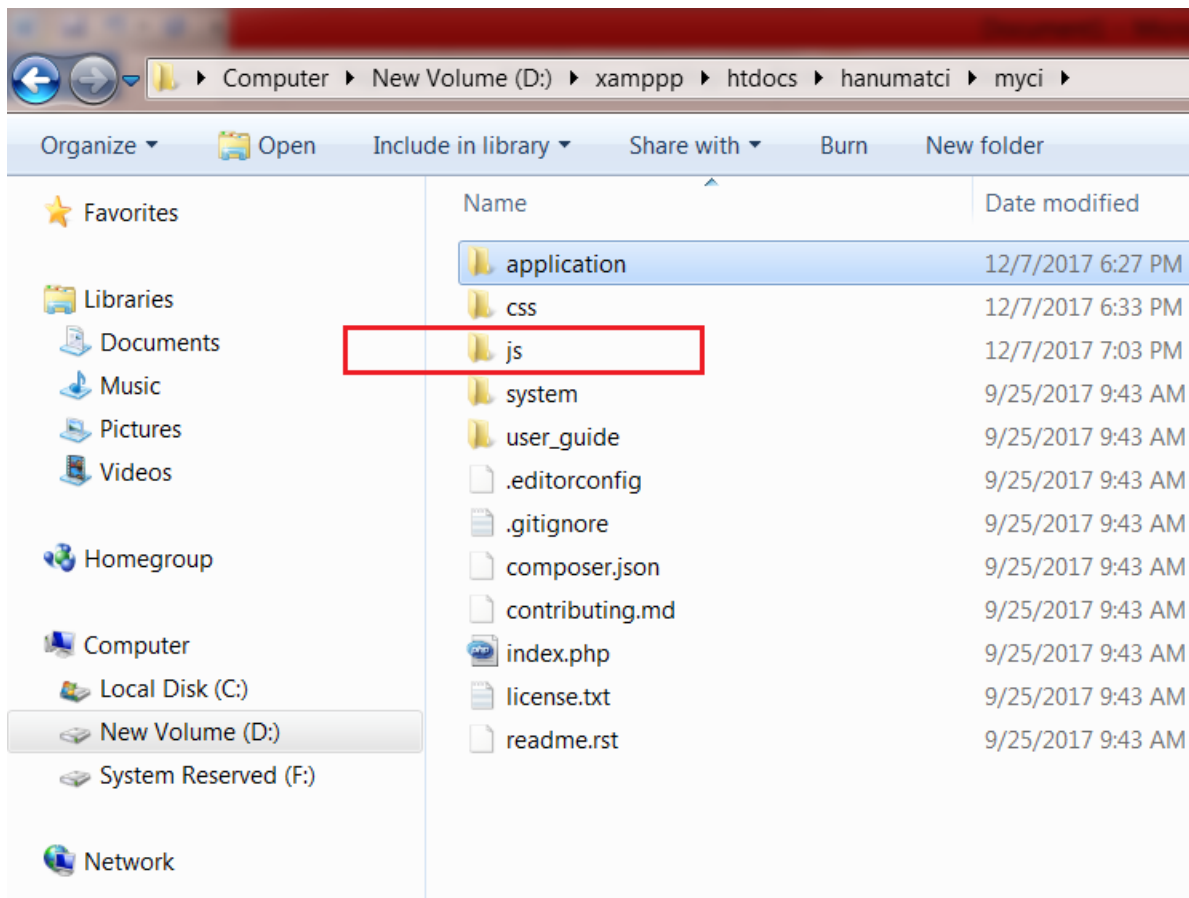


Loading JS file :

Step 1:

Open your myci folder (for Codeigniter) & create js folder :



Step 2 :

Write code in external.js file (PATH= myci/js/external.js):

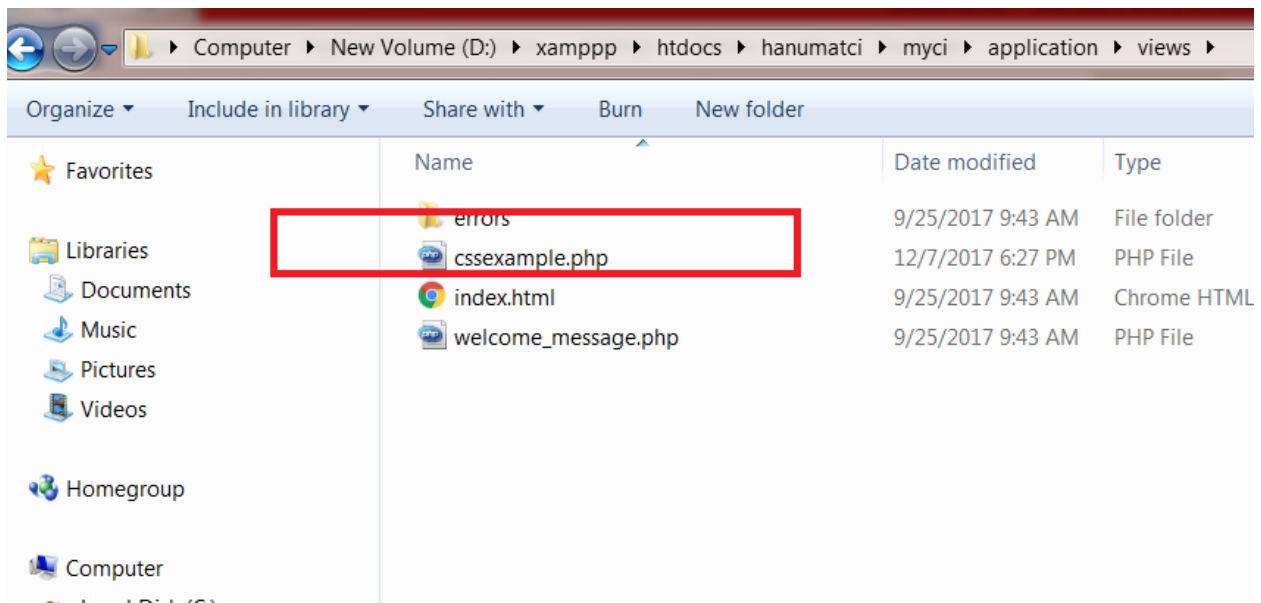

Write code for cssexample.php save this file under views (PATH= application/views) :

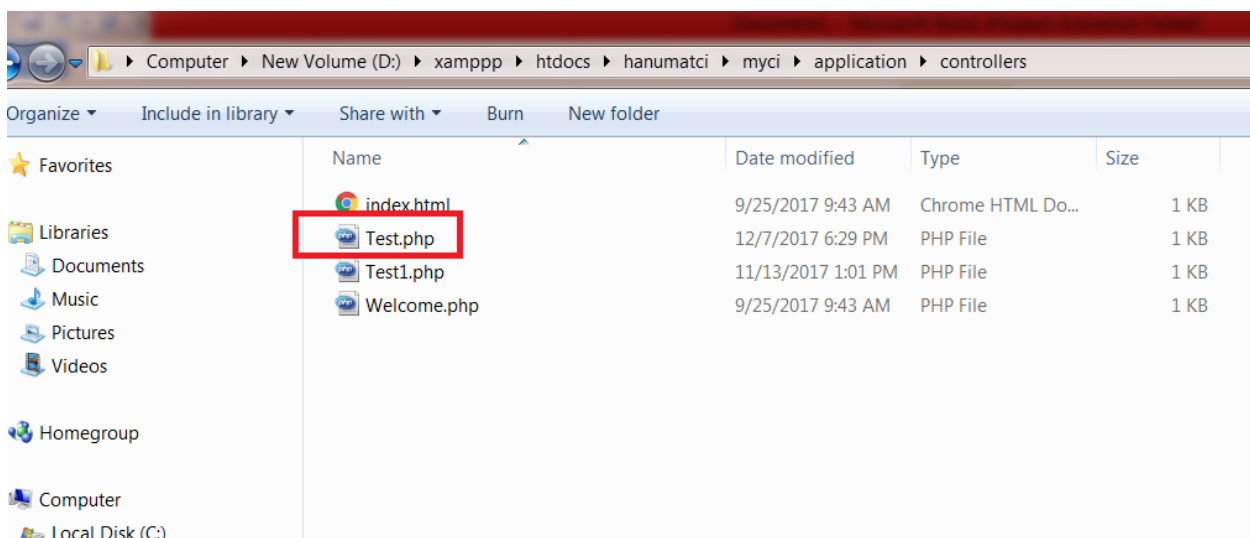

**Step 5 : write code for Test.php file and save under controllers folder
(PATH=application/controllers):**

    {

function __construct()
    {
        parent::__construct();
                $this->load->helper('url');
    }

public function hello()
    {
        $this->load->view('cssexample');

    }

    }
?>
```

Finally to run open your browser & type :

here myci is main root folder and Test is controller class name and hello is function name
