

Let's create a 5–6 page React.js website inspired by the structure and style of vissicomp.in. This guide will walk you through building a modern, responsive portfolio website with multiple sections, including Home, About, Services, Projects, Blog, and Contact.

Prerequisites

Before we begin, ensure you have the following installed:

Node.js: [Download and install](#)

Code Editor: [VS Code or any editor of your choice](#)

Git (optional but recommended): [Download and install](#)

Your website will have the following routes(paths):

/ – Home

/about – About

/services – Services

/projects – Projects

/blog – Blog

/contact – Contact

🔧 Step-by-Step Project Setup

1. Initialize React App

```
npx create-react-app vissicomp-clone
```

```
cd vissicomp-clone
```

```
npm install react-router-dom
```

```
npm start
```

2. Create File Structure

Inside src create two folder

components & pages.

3. App.js – Main App Setup with Routing

4. Navigation Bar (Navbar.js) :-

// src/components/Navbar.js  
  
import React from 'react';  
import { Link } from 'react-router-dom';  
import './Navbar.css'; // Optional for styling  
  
const Navbar = () => {  
  return (  
    <nav className="navbar">  
      <h2 className="logo">Vissicomp</h2>  
      <ul className="nav-links">  
        <li><Link to="/">Home</Link></li>  
        <li><Link to="/about">About</Link></li>  
        <li><Link to="/services">Services</Link></li>  
        <li><Link to="/projects">Projects</Link></li>  
        <li><Link to="/blog">Blog</Link></li>  
        <li><Link to="/contact">Contact</Link></li>  
      </ul>  
    </nav>  
  );  
};
```

Optional CSS (Navbar.css)

```
.navbar {  
  display: flex;  
  justify-content: space-between;  
  padding: 20px;  
  background: #333;  
  color: white;  
}
```

.nav-links {  
  list-style: none;  
  display: flex;  
  gap: 20px;  
}
```

.nav-links li a {  
  color: white;  
  text-decoration: none;  
}
```

5. Footer.js

```
// src/components/Footer.js

import React from 'react';

const Footer = () => (

  <footer style={{ textAlign: 'center', padding: '20px', background: '#eee' }}>

    <p>&copy; 2025 Vissicomp. All rights reserved.</p>

  </footer>

);

export default Footer;
```

6. Pages

You'll create one page per route:

src/pages/Home.js

```
const Home = () => (

);

export default Home;
```

src/pages/About.js

```
const About = () => (  
  <div>  
    <h1>About Us</h1>  
    <p>We are an innovative IT services company...</p>  
  </div>  
);  
  
export default About;
```

src/pages/Services.js

```
const Services = () => (  
  <div>  
    <h1>Our Services</h1>  
    <ul>  
      <li>Web Development</li>  
      <li>App Development</li>  
      <li>Cloud Solutions</li>  
    </ul>  
  </div>  
);
```

export default Services;
```

src/pages/Projects.js
```

```
const Projects = () => (
```

```
  <div>
```

```
    <h1>Projects</h1>
```

```
    <p>Here are some of our past works...</p>
```

```
export default Projects;
```

```
src/pages/Blog.js
```

```
const Blog = () => (
```

```
  <div>

    <h1>Blog</h1>

```

export default Blog;

src/pages/Contact.js
```

```
const Contact = () => (  
  <div>  
    <h1>Contact Us</h1>  
    <form>  
      <label>Name</label>  
      <input type="text" placeholder="Your name" />  
      <label>Email</label>  
      <input type="email" placeholder="Your email" />  
      <label>Message</label>  
      <textarea placeholder="Your message"></textarea>  
      <button type="submit">Send</button>  
    </form>  
  </div>  
);
```

export default Contact;

✔ Now You're Done!

You can now run:

npm start

This launches your full React site with navigation!
