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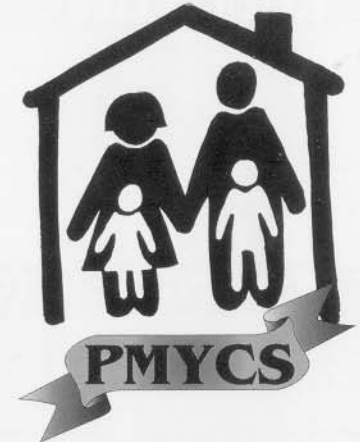

PATCHOGUE-MEDFORD YOUTH AND COMMUNITY SERVICES, INC. is a non-profit organization serving the Patchogue-Medford community.

We offer educational, recreational, youth development & intervention programs for youth up to age 21. Outreach, advocacy, resources & referrals are provided for families.

CHILDREN SERVICES

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

Children in grades 1-5 participate in crafts, cooperative games, educational/recreational activities, movies, and special events.

EDUCATION

TUTORING

Free tutoring is available for students in grades 1-12. Tutoring is provided by youth and adult volunteers. Students meet with their tutors 1 hour per week at the Patchogue-Medford Library.

ADOLESCENT SERVICES

YOUTH COUNCIL

The Youth Council is a group of motivated and responsible teens, ages 12-19, who meet weekly. Youth council members volunteer in the community, coordinate fundraisers & recreational events, discuss issues important to youth, learn new skills, have fun and meet new people. Membership is always open.



WRAP

Winning Rewards through After-School Programs - A daily after-school program for middle school students attending South Ocean and Oregon Middle Schools designed to enhance self-esteem, improve decision-making skills, promote healthy choices and reduce negative behaviors. The program provides homework assistance and educational workshops as well as sports and recreational activities in a supervised setting.

JOBLINE

This employment program assists youth, ages 14-21, in searching for, applying for and maintaining a job. Local businesses and residents list current employment opportunities in our jobline book. We also offer employment skills workshops on filling out applications, resume writing and interviewing skills.

TRACKS

Teens Riding for Adventure, Culture and Knowledge in Society - This donation-based program is designed to enable PMYCS to provide teens with an opportunity to explore the treasure chest of culture New York City has to offer. Supervised events will be organized for our young people to visit Museums, Theaters, Government agencies, Historical sites, etc. PMYCS encourages the community to donate transportation tickets (ie: LIRR) or funds to purchase tickets to support this program.

WORKSHOPS

Acting, art and music workshops are offered throughout the year. Workshops are taught by experienced Instructors.

FAMILY SERVICES

PROJECT VISION

A project for families of students in grades 6-9 who attend South Ocean Middle School. In-school individual and/or group counseling is provided for the student. A Family Advocate provides case management and parent workshops for the family. Families must fit within Federal income guidelines.

PROJECT STRIVE

A project for families of students in grades 4-5 who attend River and Medford Elementary Schools. This prevention program provides after-school groups and activities for the student and workshops for their parent(s).

CLOTHING CLOSET

Free clothing and baby items are available to individuals and families. Please call for hours of operation. This program is sponsored in collaboration with SNAP.

RECREATION

DROP-IN LOUNGE

This program provides youth, ages 12-19, the opportunity to play pool, foosball, ping-pong, video games, listen to music, read, use computers, play board games, watch movies, socialize and participate in special events in a safe and supervised setting.

SUMMER BASKETBALL

Children in grades 5-9 have the opportunity to play basketball at a community park. This program is co-sponsored by the Village of Patchogue Parks and Recreation.

FIELD TRIPS

Through generous donations and fundraising activities, PMYCS is occasionally able to offer field trips to the youth of Patchogue and Medford. Trips are scheduled based on available funding. The objective of providing field trips is to provide young people with opportunities for a positive, supervised recreation activity.
