- 1. What animal would you choose to describe your personality? Explain your choice.**
- 2. John calls Jesus the “Lamb of God.” What is the significance of this title?**
- 3. There is no description of John baptizing Jesus. What features of the baptism do appear in the text? (See Mark 1.9-11; Matthew 3.13-17; Luke 3.21-22).**
- 4. When you get some good news, who is the first person you want to share it with?**
- 5. In verse 38 Jesus asks the two disciples, “What do you want?” How would you answer Jesus’ question?**
- 6. What do the two disciples ask Jesus and how does he respond? What would it be like to spend the day with Jesus?**

- 7. What was the first thing Andrew did after his encounter with Jesus?**

- 8. What is the significance of Simon's name change?**

- 9. Can you name someone who saw potential in you even before you saw it in yourself? What gift did that person see?**

- 10. What was Nathaniel's first reaction to Philip's news about Jesus?**

- 11. What helped Nathaniel to overcome his skepticism?**

- 12. Which one of the disciples are you most like when it comes to following Jesus: "spreading the news" Andrew and Philip, "new creation" Peter or "moving from doubt to faith" Nathaniel?**
