

ORLEANS TEEN SKI CLUB RULES, REGULATIONS & INFORMATION

The aim of the Orleans Teen Ski Club is to provide an enjoyable atmosphere for its members and guests. In attempting to meet this objective, the Board of Directors has developed the following Rules and Regulations. These were developed over the past number of ski seasons, not only to protect the individual member's interests, but also the Club and the volunteers. The information provided will assist members in the smooth and enjoyable day to day operation of the club. Your participation and co-operation will be greatly appreciated.

REGISTRATION AND MEMBERSHIP

REGISTRATION IS OPEN TO THOSE TEENAGERS BETWEEN THE AGES OF 13 AND 18 INCLUSIVE. SIBLINGS ACCOMPANIED BY AN OLDER MEMBER WILL BE PERMITTED.

1. Membership fees may be paid by cheque or cash.
2. Refunds will not be granted after the first trip unless the request is accompanied by a medical certificate or other written explanation. All refunds will be pro-rated and a administrative fee will be applied.
3. All members must be in possession of their Orleans Teen Ski Club identification card at all times.
4. Members who do NOT have their cards at the bus will be charged the Guest Rate of \$20.00 for that trip.
5. Members who have lost their card will be charged an administrative fee of \$5.00 for a new card and must produce a current photograph. School pictures will be accepted.
6. Members who bring guests are responsible for the conduct of their guests and all club rules apply to them.

GUESTS

7. Guests will be charged a fee of \$20.00 for all local trips and the appropriate fees for the away trips. Payment must be in cash. Trips to the Laurentians are normally \$40.00 while trips to a further destination is set at \$50.00.
8. Guests may not pre-register unless asked to do so.
9. Seating capacity may restrict the number of guests that can be taken. Unfortunately these numbers are not known before hand.
10. The Club reserves the right to permit guests.
11. Guests must follow all Club Rules and Regulations.

GENERAL BUS SKI CHALET RULES

1. Ski and snowboard bags are compulsory. Skis and boards 100 cm or shorter are exempted. Bags should be clearly marked for easy identification. The bags protect the skis when being loaded and off loaded.
2. Buses will commence loading at 2.30 pm and are scheduled to depart at 3.00 pm from the North East parking lot at the Orleans Sportsplex on Youville Drive.
3. Buses will start loading at 9.00 pm at the ski hill and will depart at 9.30 pm.
4. Parents should be at the Sportsplex at about 10 pm to pick up skiers.

5. Departure times for the Away trips will be announced well in advance of each trip.
6. Smoking and the consumption of alcoholic beverages on the buses is NOT permitted.
7. Use of profane language on the buses WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
8. Normal group conduct is expected and should not be intrusive to others.
9. Walkman and similar equipment will be permitted on the buses but MUST NOT be used in a manner that will be bothersome to others.
10. Unacceptable conduct on the buses, in the chalet or on the ski hill will result in disciplinary action being taken. This can be a simple verbal warning up to and including the suspension of the member for the remainder of the ski season.
11. The Board of Directors will review each case and will advise the member and his or her parent of its decision. In the case of a suspension, refunds will NOT be given.
12. While a suspension is in-effect, the member may NOT participate in Club activities.
13. At NO TIME are members or their guests permitted in the bar areas where alcoholic beverages are sold. Nor are they permitted to consume alcoholic beverages while participating in Club activities.
14. Members and their guests must return on the same bus that they traveled to the hill on.
15. Members and their guests may NOT leave the ski hill unless prior written permission is provided to the Bus Captain.
16. Members and guests must obey all ski resort rules and regulations and act appropriately while in and around the chalet.
17. All garbage will be put in the garbage receptacles both on the buses and in the chalet.
18. Vandalism and the infraction of the rules WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

The ORLEANS TEEN SKI CLUB is a not for profit community based club providing an opportunity for the youth of the local community to participate in skiing and snowboarding activities. This Club is run by volunteers for the benefit of its participants.

The Board of Directors of the Orleans Teen Ski Club and the volunteers who supervise the activities waive any responsibility or liability for any injury or loss of property that may occur during an Orleans Teen Ski Club activity.

Furthermore, by accepting to have my child participate in the club's activities, I as Parent or Guardian am aware that participating in skiing or snowboarding has many inherent risks. I freely accept and fully assume all such risks dangers and hazards as well as the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage or loss, resulting therefrom. I further accept liability caused by my child or by their guests and furthermore exonerate the Orleans Teen Ski Club, the Board of Directors and volunteers from any liability whatsoever.

I also understand that it is my responsibility to cover all medical and transportation expenses for an injury that may require medical attention during an Orleans Teen Ski Club activity.
