Membership Renewal 2002 Information

It is time once again for a reminder that the OUDES year runs alongside the calendar and that therefore we must ask you to re-new your membership for 2002.

Please note the following changes:

- Cheques for membership fees (and for any future OUDES events) should be made out to OUSA (Open University Students Association), as from January 2002 our banking will be operated through them.
- Your renewal form and fee should be sent to John Armitage at the address given on the renewal form and **not to Alan Foster** as John has kindly agreed to take over the position of Membership Secretary.

There are however 4 categories of people who do not need to send in their £5 membership fee as their membership will be automatically renewed for 2002. They are:

1. Tutors and course team members of any of the Development and Environment Courses, who are automatically offered Honorary Membership of the Society.
2. Students who joined after the August 2001 whose membership will therefore run for a further year.
3. Anyone who paid £10 last year will have been joined up for 2001 and 2002.
4. Everyone who ATTENDED the 2001 revision weekend. As the attendance was much higher than anticipated, the overheads per head were lower, and rather than send out 70+ cheques in refund the committee have agreed that the attendees will have their membership fee for 2002 paid from the revision weekend funds.
