Is the SUBSTRATUM of the accidents by GIVING the accidents the act of being. In this sense, is ACT. 2. Is the CAUSE of those accidents which arise from it. ACT. 3. Has a PASSIVE POTENCY of receiving further perfections conferred on it by the accidents.

STAGES IN THE KNOWLEDGE OF BEING (COMPOSITE OF SUBSTANCE AND ACCIDENTS)

1. Vague knowledge of the composite.
2. Perception of the accidents.
3. From the accidents, a certain knowledge of the substance.
4. From the substance, a deeper knowledge of the accidents.
