Directions to the Jones' home:**From square in Red Lion:**

Take Rt. 24 south, go about 4 miles just past the Winterstown Fire hall. Turn right onto Swamp Road (also called Rt. 216). Go about 50 feet and turn left onto Mt. Olivet Rd. (street sign is missing). Go 2.9 miles turn right on Rehmeyers Hollow Road. (this is right before the trailer park). Go 1.1 miles just past a brown two story, on the right is our mailbox, and driveway is on the left across from the mailbox. Go up driveway and park. The address is:

Directions to Mike Spangler's house:**From Clearview School:**

Go South on Rt. 74 to Chanceford Rd. (about 2 miles)
(If you get to Miller's fuel tanks you went to far)
Turn left unto Chanceford Road
Go about 2/10 of a mile to the first dirt road on the right, this is Burns Rd.
Turn right onto Burns Rd.
Go to the first house on the right after you pass through the woods.
