Our annual popcorn sale has begun. You should have received your popcorn papers in your purple folder. This is our BIG fundraiser for the year. Each scout is asked to sell \$150.00. This profit is what keeps our pack running. With this money we pay for belt loops, pins, patches, and other awards that each scout earns throughout the year.

Our budget this year is \$3,735.00 for the pack to operate. If you choose not to sell popcorn there is a \$40 buyout to pay for your son's advancements. This amount will be pro rated. (Example- Sell \$75 or popcorn and you will pay a \$20 buyout).

Rules While at the School
