2006 Holiday Wreath Fundraiser Guidelines

- This page contains all the information for those Pack 1703 families who choose to participate in the 2006 Holiday Wreath Fundraiser. Remember, you can opt out of the fundraiser by writing a check to Pack 1703 for \$160.
- Individual wreath prices are as follows:
 - ▶ 24 Inch Diameter Wreath - \$16 No multiple sale discounts
 - ▶ 42 Inch Diameter Wreath - \$42 One large wreath counts as two small wreaths towards credit
- Dates for this year's sale are as follows:
 - ▶ Final orders due Monday October 30. Please give a **COPY** of the order form due to your Den Leader
 - ▶ Wreath pick-up and payment is Saturday November 18.
 - A check payable to 'Pack 1703',
 - Time: Noon – 5:00 PM
 - Location: Jodi Nowakowski's house at 757 Barclay.
- For the Wreath Sale, the Pack has a 20 Wreath Minimum – Sliding Scale Buyout Will Be in Effect
Basically, you receive an \$8 credit for each wreath sold towards the buyout amount. For Example if you sell five wreaths:

\$160	Buyout amount
- \$40	(5 x \$8) Credit from Wreaths Sold
<u>+\$80</u>	(5 x \$16) Cost of Wreaths Sold
\$200	Total Due

You may sell more wreaths than 20. Then the calculation is simply the selling price of the wreath (22 wreaths x \$16) = \$352
- Cub Scouts may sell wreaths to nearly any person or business, but should always be accompanied by an adult. Safety is always our primary concern.
- Families are encouraged to have their customers pre-pay their individual order. COD is OK if families think they can trust their customer. However, every family is responsible for payment of the entire order when it is picked up on November 18 – No Exceptions.
- Use of the attached *Sales Receipt* form is strongly recommended. In addition, many Cub Scouts write personal thank-you letters.
- Accepting cash from customers is OK, but families MUST keep all cash and write one check to Pack 1703 for the amount when picking up their order. The Pack must have an audit trail and dealing with large amounts of cash makes it too hard. Therefore, cash will not be accepted at pick-up.
- Final orders are due to Den Leaders on Monday October 30 along with a **COPY** of the wreath order form – families should keep the original so they know where to deliver orders.
- Orders are to be picked up at (Jodi Nowakowski's house at 757 Barclay) on Saturday November 18 from Noon – 5:00 PM. Wreaths, pinecones and bows will be given out in bulk – each family is responsible for final assembly of the wreath by adding the pinecones and bows (a simple task) before final delivery to your customers.
