Supplies: Large poster board, felt pens, star stickers, glue sticks, boys bring their drawings on 5x7 paper

Activity:

This is the wrap up to the Citizenship Belt Loop and Pin.

Discussion: “During the last several months we have been working on earning our Citizenship Belt Loop and Pin. What are some of the things we did (ask the boys to comment): pick up litter, donated new clothes to Jamison Center, made the collage “What American Means to Me”, rode the Pack’s Veteran’s Day parade float, went to the Fire Station Open House, etc. To be a good citizen means we need to show concern for the community, environment, history, and other people. Our personal values play an important role in the decisions we make and the actions we take.”
