
## **Arrow Point 10C**

# Supplies:

Large brown grocery paper bag Felt pens scissors

# Instructions:

- Cut bag up the middle on a wide side.
- Cut out a circle on the bottom of the bag (see dotted lines in diagram.) (The bottom of the bag acts as the shoulders of the vest.)
- Cut large armholes on the short sides of the bag near the bottom part of the bag (see dotted lines in diagram.)


# Instructions:

### Quiver:

- Decorate construction paper with word pictures (pages 153-155), stickers, stamps, etc.
- Cover Pringle's can with decorated construction paper tape in place.
- Use brads to attach string to either end of the can (see black spots on diagram.)


# Arrow:


- Insert cardboard arrow into one end of the dowel with white glue.
- Boys cut edges of feather shapes to make fringe.
- Insert construction paper feathers into other end of dowel with white glue.



# **Arrow Point 10D**

Cut out patterns. Cut arrowhead out of heavy cardboard. Cut feather out of colored construction paper and fringe the edge. Tape arrowhead to one end of dowel stick and two feathers to other end.

# Supplies:

Drum: Stick: 11.5 oz. coffee cans (boys bring) Sticks Vinyl (pre-cut) Batting Brown yarn Brown yarn

# Instructions:

### Drum:

- Stretch pre-cut vinyl over top and bottom of coffee can.
- Insert yarn through pre-punched holes (wrap tape around the end of the yarn to be put through the holes). Pull tight-like lacing on a shoe and knot.

### Stick:

- Wrap small amount of batting on end of stick.
- Cover batting end with pre-cut chamois piece and tie on with string.
