Scout Night at the Birdcage Leader's Information

- ❑ Collect & Turn in all registrations at one time to ensure your unit sits together (*We will not guarantee complete group seating after May 13, 2009*). Please submit one check for your unit.
- ❑ Pick up your unit's tickets and vouchers at the stadium the day of the game.

- **Adult Leadership:** Each unit attending is responsible for providing at a minimum two-deep leadership throughout the entire game. NO EXCEPTIONS
- Remember to wear your Scout Uniforms. Only Scouts in uniforms will be allowed on the warning track for the National Anthem.
- Please remind adults not to drink alcohol while wearing their uniform
- In case of rain-out, tickets will be exchanged on an individual basis through the Sioux Falls Canaries

- ❑ After the Game Campout on the Field & Saturday Morning Activities
 - **All tents MUST be STEAKLESS!!**
 - The event coordinator **MUST** be onsite during the entire campout and have in his/her possession Class 1 Medical Form "Health History & Release" from **ALL** unit participants (adults, youth and siblings).
 - **Adult Leadership:** Each unit is responsible for providing its own leadership during the campout, and **MUST** follow all requirements in the *Guide to Safe Scouting* under Family Camping. NO EXCEPTIONS
 - Breakfast will be provided from 6:15-7:00 AM on Saturday Morning at a cost of \$5.40 per person. Breakfast includes: Bacon, Eggs, Hash Browns, Toast and Juice or Milk
 - A Baseball Clinic with Canaries players will take place from 7:00-8:30 AM. Those wishing to participate must bring a glove.
