

# March block of the Month

## Drunkard's Path Block

8 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished block

**Fabrics** Piece A or the concave: Dark Green, Concave- the curve "caves" in.  
Piece B or the convex: Light Green, Convex- the curve is out.

**Cut** 4 Piece A or the concave: Dark Green  
4 Piece B or the convex: Light Green

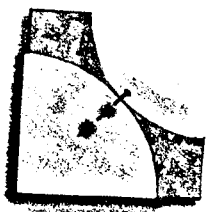
### Instructions

**Step 1.** Pinning : Fold the pieces in half and finger press to find the center. If you fold one piece with right sides together and the other piece with wrong sides together, you will find they nest into each other easier. Pin in center. See **Figure 1** Holding it in hand, pin the edge, then pin between that pin and the center pin. Repeat on the other half. Clipping the seams is usually not required because of the bias edge. **Figure 2**

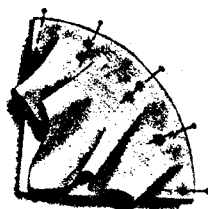
**Step 2.** Sew with the quarter circle Piece B ( the flat piece, now that it has been pinned) on the bottom. **Figure 3.**

**Step 3.** Press gently on the right side to prevent small pleats. Press the seams towards the dark Fabric. The curve is on the bias, so be careful not to stretch it as you press.

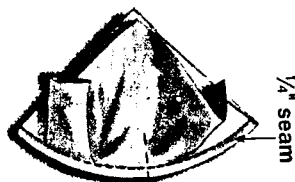
**Step 4.** Sew blocks together with dark green to meet in center. **Figure 4**



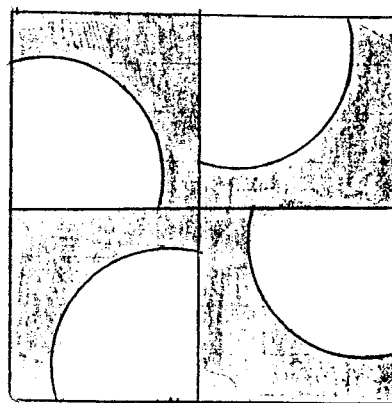
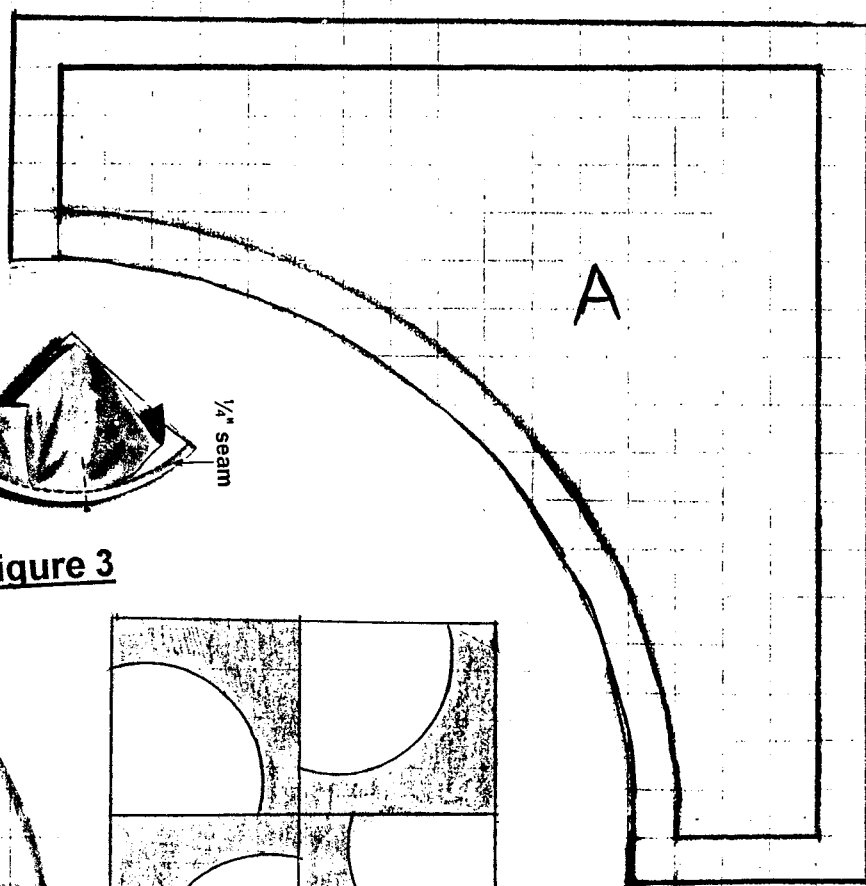
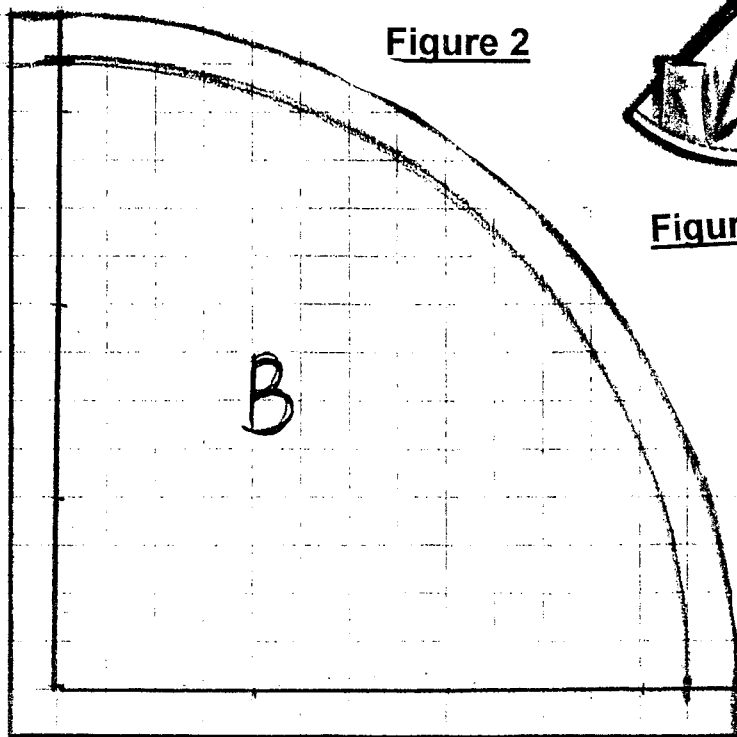
