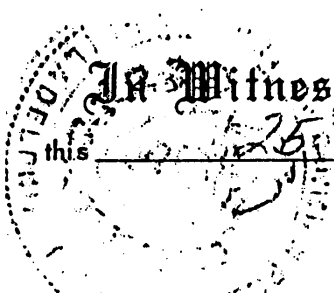
SUR CHARGE OF MURDER

1st degree Murder

And now, May 25, 1983

the sentence of the law is that you, Mumia Abu-Jamal aka Wesley Cook,
be taken hence by the Sheriff of Philadelphia County to the jail of that county from whence you came, and from
thence in due course to the State Correctional Institution at Rockview in Centre County, Pennsylvania, and that
you there suffer death during the week fixed by the Governor of the Commonwealth, in a building erected for the
purpose on land owned by the Commonwealth, such punishment being inflicted by either the warden or deputy
warden of the State Correctional Institution at Rockview, or by such person as the warden shall designate, by
causing to pass through your body a current of electricity of intensity sufficient to cause death and the appli-
cation of such current to be continued until you are dead. May God in His Infinite Goodness have mercy on your
soul.
