

Pelco Loses 5th Straight

It's hard for this reporter to figure, how Pelco can look so good some days and then look so terrible on others. As the boys in navy blue lost their 5th straight game last night by a score of 17-0. That is the third time that Pelco has been shutout this year, with a combined 11 hits over the three games and hitting into 7 double plays. It is really hard to fathom. It is like Pelco has two different teams. Pelco's average for the first 7 games was 86-for-181, a .475 average with a 3-4 record and outscoring their opponents 62-59. In the last 5 games they are 0-5 while batting .353, that is 42-for-119. With the exception of 1 game that they scored 11 runs on 19 hits, a game in which they lost 17-11, the Pelco bats have been silent. The other 4 games they have been outscored 75-9. Also in those 4 games, Pelco is a dismal 23-for-79, a pitiful .291 batting average. Pelco's next game is tonight at 6:30 pm at Rockland Community College.
