PHBA AMATEUR ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION (date of birth required)

A person is considered an amateur exhibitor when s/he is no longer eligible to show in PHBA youth activity classes and meets the following qualifications for the previous five (5) calendar years;

A. Is a person who has not shown, judged, trained, or assisted in training a horse for remuneration, either directly or indirectly;

B. Is a person who has not received compensation for instructing another person in riding, driving, training, or showing a horse competition;

C. Premium money is not considered remuneration;

D. Payment of entry fees or other expenses by any person other than the amateur or those persons found in Rule(s) 5205 is to be considered remuneration;

E. Within the five calendar years previous to application for amateur membership an individual cannot hold membership accreditation in the following organizations: Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association, Women's Professional Rodeo Association, International Professional Rodeo Association and the Women's Professional Rodeo Association All Women's Rodeo for those events or classes which are the same events or classes the individual competes, or desires to compete, in PHBA amateur competition. For example, a person who competes in a PRCA roping event may not compete in amateur calf roping, daily team roping (heading or heeling) by may show in any other amateur classes.

F. Or has not, nor during the periods of amateur status cannot, show, train or assist in the training of a horse for which an immediate family member accepts remuneration, monetary or otherwise, either directly or indirectly, for training, assisting in the training, or showing of said horse;

I agree to comply with PHBA's rules and regulations. I understand that if for any reason, I should become ineligible to compete in approved amateur classes, I have the affirmative duty to immediately and voluntarily surrender my PHBA Amateur Membership Card.

PHBA NOVICE AMATEUR or NOVICE YOUTH MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION (date of birth required)

Novice Amateurs or Novice Youth Eligibility. A person is considered a Novice Amateur Youth exhibitor when they meet the following qualifications for the previous five (5) calendar years as found in Rule(s) 5201 A-G;

A. Exhibitors cannot have earned a total of seventy-five (75) or more lifetime performance points in all PHBA divisions or programs (ie open, amateur, novice-amateur, amateur-select or youth) combined;

1) Halter, color, and longe line points are not used in calculating Novice Amateur or Novice Youth status;

B. The Novice Amateur or Novice Youth cannot have won a World Champion title in PHBA; EXCEPTION Halter, color, longe line, novice amateur or novice youth classes;

C. The Novice Amateur or Novice Youth cannot have won a World Champion title in any other equine organization; EXCEPTION Halter, color, longe line, novice amateur or novice youth classes;

D. The Novice Amateur or Novice Youth cannot have earned more than twenty-five points in any other equine organization; EXCEPTION Halter, color, longe line, novice amateur or novice youth classes;

E. The Novice Amateur or Novice Youth cannot have earned more than \$5000 in cash awards in PHBA or any other equine organization; EXCEPTION Halter, color, longe line, novice amateur or novice youth classes;

F. Any individual that has been a horse show judge is ineligible.

MEMBERSHIP TYPES

Membership Required To Show. All of the owner(s) of a horse, as listed on the horse's current PHBA registration certificate (including but not limited to: spouses, partners), and the exhibitor(s) must be a current member(s) of PHBA or PHBA-Y, in order to show and for PHBA to tabulate the horse's show points in the open, youth, youth novice, amateur, amateur select or novice amateur divisions and to be eligible for any and all awards and/or titles.

PHBA Amateur and Novice-Amateur Memberships. Persons

nineteen (19) years of age or older who meet the eligibility requirements as outlined in the Amateur Program Rules or Novice Amateur Program, may become members of PHBA and the PHBA Amateur Association (PHBA-A).

Lifetime Memberships. A lifetime membership in PHBA shall be issued for a one-time fee, plus the annual APA fee and the subscription fee for Palomino Horses Magazine.

NOVICE AMATEUR PROGRAM

Novice-Amateur Eligibility.

A person is considered an Novice Amateur exhibitor by PHBA when s/he is no longer eligible to show in PHBA youth activity classes and meets the following qualifications for the previous five (5) calendar years as found in 5201 A-F and:

- A. Exhibitors cannot have earned a total of fifty- (50) or more lifetime performance points in all PHBA divisions or programs (i.e. open, amateur, novice-amateur, amateur-select or youth) combined.
 1. Halter, color, and longe line points are not used in calculating Novice Amateur status.
 2. Example: Ten (10) youth showmanship points and twenty-five (25) open western pleasure points and fifteen (15) amateur hunter under saddle points equal

fifty (50) total points, making this exhibitor ineligible for the Novice Amateur Division.

- B. The Novice Amateur cannot have won a World Champion title in PHBA; EXCEPTION: halter, color, and longe line and novice amateur classes.
- C. The Novice Amateur cannot have won a World Champion title in any other equine organization; EXCEPTION: halter, color, and longe line and novice amateur classes.
- D. The Novice Amateur cannot have earned more than twenty-five points in any other equine organization; EXCEPTION: halter, color, and longe line classes.
- E. The Novice Amateur can not have earned more than \$5000 in cash awards in PHBA or any other equine organization; EXCEPTION: halter, color, longe line classes.
- F. Any individual that has been a horse show judge is ineligible

AMATEUR PROGRAM

Eligibility.

A person is considered an amateur exhibitor by PHBA when s/he is no longer eligible to show in PHBA youth activity classes and meets the following qualifications for the previous five (5) calendar years:

- A. Is a person, who has not shown, judged, trained, or assisted in training a horse for remuneration, either directly or indirectly.
- B. Is a person who has not received compensation for instructing another person in riding, driving, training, or showing a horse in competition.
- C. Premium money is not considered remuneration.
- D. Payment of entry fees or other expenses by any person other than the amateur or those persons found in 5205 is to be considered remuneration.

- E. Cannot hold membership accreditation in a professional association for those events or classes, which are the same events, or classes the individual competes or desires to compete in PHBA Amateur competition. (i.e. a person who competes in a Professional Rodeo Cowboy Association roping events may not compete in amateur calf roping, dally team-roping heading, dally team roping heeling, but may show in any other amateur classes.
- F. A permit holder is not considered as one who has member accreditation in a professional organization and may compete in any PHBA Amateur class.
- G. Any horse show judge is ineligible.

NOVICE YOUTH PROGRAM

PHBA-Youth Memberships.

Membership is open to any youth eighteen (18) years of age and younger with the age based on their age as of December 31st of the previous year.

Age Requirements.

Refer to PHBA Article 11, Section 8.

- A. The minimum age of a youth exhibitor is five (5) years.
- B. If a youth is thirteen (13) years of age on December 31st, of the preceding year, s/he will show as a thirteen (13)-year-old for the next calendar year, even though s/he may become fourteen (14) within the show year.
- C. The maximum age is eighteen (18) years. However, if a youth is eighteen (18) years of age on December 31st, of the preceding year, s/he will show as an eighteen (18) year-old for the next calendar year, even though s/he may become nineteen (19) within the show year.

Novice-Youth Eligibility.

A person is considered a Novice Youth exhibitor by PHBA when a youth has meet the following qualifications for the previous five (5) calendar years as found in:

- A. Exhibitors cannot have earned a total of fifty- (50) or more

lifetime performance points in all PHBA divisions or programs (i.e. open, Youth, novice-Youth) combined.

1. Halter, color, and longe line points are not used in calculating Novice Youth status.
2. Example: Ten (10) youth showmanship points and twenty-five (25) open western pleasure points and fifteen (15) Youth hunter under saddle points equal fifty- (50) total points, making this exhibitor ineligible for the Novice Youth Division.
- B. The Novice Youth cannot have won a World Champion title in PHBA; EXCEPTION: halter, color, and longe line and novice Youth classes.
- C. The Novice Youth cannot have won a World Champion title in any other equine organization; EXCEPTION: halter, color, and longe line and novice Youth classes.
- D. The Novice Youth can not have earned more than twenty-five points in any other equine organization; EXCEPTION: halter, color, longe line classes.
- E. The Novice Youth can not have earned more than \$5000 in cash awards in PHBA or any other equine organization; EXCEPTION: halter, color, longe line classes.
- F. Any individual that has been a horse show judge is ineligible
