Instruction to Fu-Shing Chinese Restaurant in Pasadena

The Fu Shing Chinese Restaurant is located at 2960 East Colorado Boulevard in Pasadena, east of San Gabriel and west of Madre Street. The nearest cross street is El Nido, and the restaurant is at the southeast corner of Colorado and El Nido, within the El Nido Plaza. If you travel via 110 Pasadena Freeway, please go all the way to Pasadena, and the end of 110 Freeway becomes Arroyo Parkway. Continue going north on Arroyo until you reach Colorado Blvd, then make a right turn to Colorado until you pass San Gabriel. El Nido is about four blocks passed San Gabriel to your right. You will see Chrysler and Chevrolet Car Dealerships to your left (north side of Colorado), and Fu Shing Chinese Restaurant will be across the street on the south side of Colorado. There is a parking lot behind the restaurant for the El Nido Plaza. You may enter the parking lot via El Nido by making a right turn onto El Nido from Colorado, followed by an immediate left turn to the entrance of the parking lot.

If you are coming to Pasadena via 210 E. Freeway, please exit on San Gabriel and go south (make a right turn on San Gabriel) until you reach Colorado Blvd. Make a left turn onto Colorado and then follow the latter part of the directions given above. If you are traveling via 210 W. Freeway, please take the Madre Street exit and go south (make a left turn) on Madre until Colorado, then make a right turn onto Colorado. The restaurant will be on your left hand side. Please see the map below. Please note that there is no San Gabriel exit on 210 W. Freeway.
