➤ After **January 17, 2006**, reservation applications can only be accepted with a **\$2499 full package donation** by cash, check made out to **PFMC** and sent to **61 Cooper Road Voorhees, NJ 08043** or, charge to **MasterCard, Visa, or Discover**. The **PFMC** asks that any charges be accompanied with a **3% additional donation to cover handling fees**. Final donations were due **90 days in advance or January 17, 2006**.

➤ **Donations** to the **PFMC** for **self** or **others** may be solicited and collected to support those who cannot afford this pilgrimage. See <http://www.geocities.com/pilgrimsfaith/DonReq.pdf>.

➤ **Travel insurance** is **NOT INCLUDED** because the **cost** is **age dependent** as in most insurance. An excellent package is available and is highly advisable. **Policy application forms with costs** that range from **\$88/\$103** to **\$365/\$525** for **Part A/Parts A&B** for ages **≤30** to **≥81** will be sent with reservation confirmation letters to each pilgrim.

➤ **Special meals or dietary arrangements** are **NOT INCLUDED**. These must be arranged for **at least 10 days** before **pilgrimage departure** and **before 7 April 2006**. **Lunches and snacks** as well as **alcoholic beverages** are **not included**. Plan about **\$10** for a **light lunch** and about **\$20** for **hot lunch**.

➤ **Single Supplement (private room)** requires an additional **\$500 per person to be included with package donation**.

➤ **Transportation to/from John F. Kennedy International Airport, NY (JFK)** is **NOT INCLUDED**. Add-on air transportation is available from other airports to meet up with this pilgrimage group in **JFK**. Local limousine service information and a willingness to coordinate pilgrim transportation to **JFK** is available from the **PFMC**.

➤ **Tips or gratuities** for the **guides, hotel / religious house staff, and motor coach drivers** are **NOT INCLUDED**. The **PFMC** offers suggestions contained in letters to registered pilgrims. Plan on about **\$100**. To make it easier on pilgrims, the **PFMC** offers to collect tips or gratuities in envelopes at the airport before departure and disburse them as appropriate. Pilgrims are always welcome to add extra tips or gratuities for particularly good service.

➤ **Need for wheelchair or other medically approved assistance** must be stipulated with **medical documentation** from a **medical provider**. A **PFMC** nurse will speak to each pilgrim needing special assistance to assess the individual need. This must be approved prior to registration confirmation.

➤ The **PFMC coordinators** are responsible to assist pilgrims throughout this **PFMC** pilgrimage.

➤ An **agent coordinator, escort, or guide** will be with this pilgrimage group and available for questions about scheduling, rooms, and airline transfers. He or she will assist and coordinate the daily program with the **PFMC Coordinators** and the **Spiritual Director**. The principal guide for this pilgrimage will be **Zvi Harpaz** - he speaks **English and Spanish** so he can answer questions from **Spanish** speaking pilgrims.

➤ A **medical information sheet** will be sent with confirmation of each pilgrim's reservation. This is to be filled out completely, and sent with a **photo copy** of each pilgrim's **passport photo page**, with computer code at bottom of page visible in photocopy, to the **PFMC** at **61 Cooper Road, Voorhees, NJ 08043**.

➤ **Processing for ticketing** will not proceed until the **PFMC** has these two documents as **ticket names** must agree with **passport names** and we must **accommodate all medical needs** within the **ticketing process**. **Tickets** will be carried to **JFK** by the **PFMC Coordinators** and handed to each pilgrim in the **EI AI baggage / check-in area**.

## Planned Itinerary:

**MONDAY, 4/17/06:** Depart JFK, USA. Dinner and breakfast served on board airplane.

**TUESDAY, 4/18/06:** Arrive in Tel Aviv, Israel. Meet guide and transfer to motor coach transfer to Hotel Prima Astor in Tel Aviv for dinner and overnight. Time will be set aside daily for Holy Mass, Angelus, Rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet, Liturgy of the Hours, etc.

**WEDNESDAY, 4/19/06:** Visit Old Jaffa (Church of *Saint Peter*) and Caesarea (Acts 10) then go along the coast of the Mediterranean Sea to Mount Carmel to visit the site which overlooks the Jezreel Valley (1 Kings 18) and Stella Maris which overlooks Haifa and offers reflection on Elijah's vision (1 Kings 18:41-44). Continue across Galilee to Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight at Hotel Prima Tiberias.

**THURSDAY, 4/20/06:** Visit Cana (Wedding Miracle) and Nazareth (Annunciation and Mary's Well) in the morning. After lunch visit Mount Tabor (Transfiguration) and Yardenit (Baptism in the Jordan). Return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

**FRIDAY, 4/21/06:** Visit Mount of Beatitudes (Matthew 5:1-12), Tabgha (Loaves and Fishes, Mark 6:30-44), Mensa Christi (On this "rock" ..., John 21:1-14), Capernaum (Peter's House, Mark 4:12-17, 1:21-38) and the land of the Gadarenes (Demoniac, Matthew 8:28). Visit Kibbutz Nof Ginosar near Magdala and the museum where the remains of an actual *First Century Galilee* fishing boat can be viewed then board a replica for a cruise on the way to Tiberias for "browsing" before dinner and overnight.

**SATURDAY, 4/22/06:** Leave Tiberias via the Valley of Armagedon / Jezreel / Megiddo to reach Jerusalem for dinner and overnight at the Prima Royal Hotel. On the way, visit selected Biblical sites including sites claiming to be Emmaus as we approach Jerusalem from the northwest. Visit the Mount of Olives, Pater Noster, Dominus Fleuit (Luke 19:41-44) before dinner and overnight.

**SUNDAY, 4/23/06:** In the morning, visit Mount Zion (Cenacle Church, Upper Room (Holy Thursday – First Eucharist), David's Tomb, Church of the Dormition, and *Saint Peter in Calicantu*) prior to descending to the Garden of Gethsemane. In the afternoon, visit Ein Karem (Visitation, Luke 1:39-56, and *Saint John the Baptist*). Return to hotel for dinner and overnight.

**MONDAY, 4/24/06:** Visit Old City Jerusalem including Roman Cardo, Burnt House, Herodian Quarter, Western Wall, Southern Wall Excavation, and Dome of the Rock (if accessible). In the afternoon, visit Bethlehem (Nativity and Carmel Convent / Monastery). Return to hotel for dinner and overnight.

**TUESDAY, 4/25/06:** Visit Saint Stephen Gate, Saint Anne Church, the Pool of Bethesda (John 5:1-9), Lithostrotos (Luke 22:63-66), Ecce Homo (Luke 23:1-26) and prayerfully walk the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Visit Bethany (Lazarus, Martha, and Mary) in the afternoon. Return to hotel for dinner and overnight.

**WEDNESDAY, 4/26/06:** Free time in Jerusalem or take an excursion to a desert monastery or to Qumran, En Gedi, Massada, and the Dead Sea. Return to hotel for dinner and overnight.

**THURSDAY, 4/27/06:** Depart from Jerusalem and cross into Jordan for a visit to Mount Nebo (Moses) and Madaba (Saint George and Apostles Churches). Check in at the Petra Palace Hotel for dinner and overnight.

**FRIDAY, 4/28/06:** Spend day touring Petra. Drive back to Israel and Eilat on the shore of the Gulf of Aqaba off the Red Sea for dinner and overnight.

**SATURDAY, 4/29/06 / SUNDAY, 4/30/06:** After a leisurely morning in Eilat, drive to Tel Aviv and the Prima Astor Hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Optional Extension to Monday, 5/1/06** for a full day excursion from Eilat to Mount Sinai and Saint Catherine Monastery in Egypt for \$350 with an additional overnight in Eilat.

**SUNDAY, 4/30/06 / MONDAY, 5/1/06:** Transfer to Tel Aviv Airport for return flight to JFK.

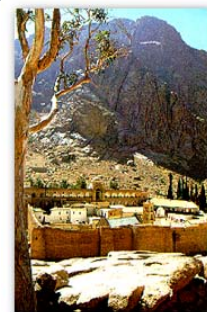

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**DONATIONS and RESERVATIONS:** A \$500 per person deposit donation is required at the time of booking a reservation, plus passenger's full name (as it appears on passport), mailing address and telephone number. Fax, internet/e-mail, or phone reservations are welcome. Deposit donation and/or donation in full must be received within 7 days of reservation or it will not be processed and will automatically cancel. **Full donation is due 90 days before departure date. If a booking is made within 90 days of departure, full donation is required at the time of booking.** If donation is to be received less than 21 days before departure, please include a \$50 late fee. No change of names is permitted after ticketing has been accomplished.

**FORM OF DONATION:** Credit Cards (Discover, Visa and Master Card) or Personal / Bank / Certified / Travelers Checks, or Money Orders, or Wire Transfers (please fax a copy of bank confirmation when wiring funds) are accepted forms of donation at any time. Credit Cards (Discover, Visa and Master Card) will incur an additional 3% charge to cover the processing fees. In order to speed the processing of deposits and final donations, please note the departure date on deposit and balance of donation checks. Every reservation must be accompanied by a signed application form. Returned checks will incur a \$25 service fee. In case of computer or human billing error, we reserve the right to re-invoice with corrected billing.

**PRICE GUARANTEE:** We can only guarantee prices when and if the pilgrimage package cost is paid in full.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Items of a personal nature, such as telephone, room service, lunch, snacks, alcoholic beverages, optional activities, and laundry. Tips to guides (\$5/day) and drivers (\$ varies per bag) and medical / travel insurance (\$ varies based on age and package cost). **Excursion \$350 and single supplement \$500** are not included. Receipt of final documents is not guaranteed if final donation is not received on time. Upon receipt of your documents you are responsible to check your itinerary, spelling of your name, dates, times and other important information.
