- Baggage handling (1 piece per person).
- All Transfers and Motor Coaches.
- Round trip air from JFK via London to Medjugorje, and, if on extension, Ireland
- English speaking Catholic guides
- Coordinator from the PFMC throughout the pilgrimage assisting with arrangements for daily Holy Mass and spiritual activities.
- All guided tours and admission fees.

NOT INCLUDED:

- Taxes of about \$300 for Medjugorje plus about \$200 for Ireland (TBA before tickets).
- Lunches, snacks, special meals, alcoholic beverages, personal items, etc.
- Cancellation/Medical/Travel Insurance.
- Transportation to/from JFK.
- Tips or Gratuities.

- All reservations are held prior to **26 July 2006** with a **\$500 deposit donation by cash, check** made out to **PFMC** and sent to **61 Cooper Road Voorhees, NJ 08043** or, **charge to MasterCard, Visa, or Discover**. The **PFMC** asks that any charges be supported with a **3% additional donation to cover handling fees**.
- After **26 July 2006 full package donations** are required with **applications**. The remainder due after deposit and other donations is **due 90 days in advance of departure, 26 July 2006**.
- **Donations to the PFMC for self or others** may be solicited and collected to support those who cannot afford this pilgrimage. See <http://www.geocities.com/pilgrimsfaith/DonReq.pdf>.
- **Travel insurance is NOT INCLUDED** because the **cost is package donation and age dependent** as in most insurance. **Costs** range from **\$67/\$123 to \$292/\$511 for Part A M/ M+I plus \$25 to \$160 for Part B** regardless of **M or M+I for ages ≤30 to ≥81**. **Policy application forms** will be sent with reservation confirmation letters to each pilgrim.
- **Special meals or dietary arrangements are NOT INCLUDED**. These must be arranged for **at least 30 days before pilgrimage departure and before 26 September 2006**. **Lunches and snacks as well as alcoholic beverages are not included**. Plan about **\$5 for a light lunch** and about **\$10 for hot lunch**.
- **Package Donation is for Double Occupancy** (two per room).
- **Single Supplement** (private room) requires an additional **\$250 M** and **\$550 M+I** per person to be included with deposit donation.
- **Transportation to/from John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK) is NOT INCLUDED**. Add-on air transportation is available

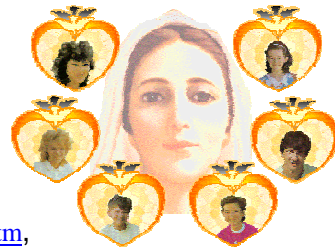
from other airports to meet up with this pilgrimage group in JFK. The **PFMC** is willing to coordinate pilgrim transportation to **JFK** using local bus, motor coach, limousine, or van service with costs covered by pilgrims.

- **Tips or gratuities for guides, hotel / private house staff, and motor coach drivers are NOT INCLUDED**. The **PFMC** offers suggestions in letters to registered pilgrims. Plan on about **\$100 M** and **\$200 M+I**. To make it easier on pilgrims, the **PFMC** offers to collect tips or gratuities in envelopes at the airport before departure and disburse them as appropriate. Pilgrims are always welcome to add extra tips or gratuities for particularly good service.
- **A medical information sheet** will be sent with confirmation of each pilgrim's reservation. This is to be filled out completely and returned to the **PFMC**. **Need for wheelchair or other medically approved assistance** must be stipulated with **medical documentation** from a **medical provider**. A **PFMC nurse** will speak to each pilgrim needing special assistance to assess the individual need. This must be approved prior to registration confirmation.
- An **agent coordinator, escort, or guide** will be available for questions about scheduling, rooms, and transfers. He or she will assist and coordinate the daily program with the **PFMC Coordinators** and **Spiritual Director**.
- We need **three photocopies** of each pilgrim's **passport photo page**, with computer code at bottom of page visible in photocopies, sent to the **PFMC**. **One photocopy** will be forwarded to **Great Experiences**.
- **Processing for ticketing** will not proceed until the **PFMC** has passport photo page copies and medical / health questionnaire form as **ticket names** must agree with **passport names** and we must **accommodate all medical needs** within the **ticketing process**. **Tickets** will be carried to **JFK** and handed to each pilgrim in the **check-in area**.

Proposed Itinerary:

THURSDAY, 10/26/06: Depart JFK. Dinner and breakfast served on board **British Airways** to London. Transfer in **Heathrow Airport** to **British Airways** for **Split, Croatia**

FRIDAY, 10/27/06: Arrive in **Split, Croatia**. Meet guide and board motor coach for trip to **Medjugorje, Bosnia-Herzegovina** for dinner and overnight. Time will be set aside daily for **Holy Mass, Angelus, Rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet** and all religious activities in the village. A guide will take us to the houses of the **Visionaries**, <http://www.gospa.com/pages/vision.htm>, up the **Hill of Apparitions**, and **Cross Mountain** <http://www.jericojourneys.com/storymessage.htm>. There are various events scheduled such as visiting the **Oasis of Peace**, the **Blue Cross**, and the **Cenacolo**, as well as **Confessions, Eucharistic Adoration, Stations of the Cross**, and various talks by the visiting priests and priests of the parish. Experience the peace and beauty of this village, and have the opportunity to share faith with thousands of pilgrims from all over the world. You will return filled with the awe of your spiritual experience, and will live the messages of **Our Lady Queen of Peace**. Visit **Father Jozo**, who was the pastor of the parish when the visions first began. We plan to have other optional excursions outside the village, i.e. to **Mostar** and / or **Dubrovnik** at a cost per person of about **\$25** each per person collected in **Medjugorje**.



THURSDAY, 11/2/06: Motor coach to **Dubrovnik, Croatia** airport for **British Airways** to **London**. Those extending for **Ireland** will transfer to a **British Airways** flight to **Dublin, Ireland**. In **Dublin**, board a motor coach for transport to the **Grand Canal Hotel**. Dinner in the hotel. Those returning home to the **USA** will remain overnight in **London** with a $\frac{1}{2}$ day sightseeing tour of **London** prior to transfer to **Heathrow** for **British Airways** to the **USA**. Return home filled with the peace of **Our Lady of Medjugorje, Queen of Peace**, on **FRIDAY, 11/3/06**.

FRIDAY, 11/3/06: Morning of sightseeing to include **Holy Mass** in the **Carmelite Monastery** then on to other sites of interest, such as **Saint Patrick's Cathedral, Christchurch Cathedral** and the **Book of Kells**. **Saint Patrick's Cathedral** is the place where **Saint Patrick** baptized the pagans into **Christianity** in the **5th Century**. **Christchurch** is the finest cathedral in **Ireland**. **Trinity College** <http://www.sacred-destinations.com/ireland/dublin-trinity-college.htm> is a residential college in the heart of the city. Here visit the **Colonnades** which houses the college's greatest treasures of which the most famous is the **Book of Kells**. This book is a magnificently illustrated, in **Celtic** design, the version of the **Gospels** designed in the monastery of **Kells** in **Meath** about the year **800**. It was presented to **Trinity College** in the mid **17th Century** to save it from **Cromwell's** army. You will also see the **Georgian Squares, O'Connell Street, the Greens, and Phoenix Park**, the largest urban parkland area in **Ireland**. The president of **Ireland** resides here.

WEDNESDAY, 11/8/06: Transfer to **Shannon Airport** and fly **Aer Lingus** to **London's Heathrow Airport** and **British Airways** to **JFK, USA**. Return home filled with the peace and the love of **Jesus** and **His Blessed Virgin Mother, Mary, Our Lady of Medjugorje, Queen of Peace**, and **Our Lady of Knock, Queen of Ireland**.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

DEPOSIT AND RESERVATION: A \$500 per person deposit donation is required at the time of booking a reservation, plus passenger's full name (as it appears on passport), mailing address and telephone number. Fax, internet/e-mail, or phone reservations are welcome. Deposit and/or donation in full must be received within 7 days of reservation or it will not be processed and will automatically cancel. Full donation is due 90 days before departure date. If a booking is made within 90 days of departure, full donation is required at the time of booking. If donation is to be received less than 21 days before departure, please include a \$50 late fee. No change of names is permitted after ticketing has been accomplished.

FORM OF DONATION: Credit Cards (Discover, Visa and Master Card) or Personal / Bank / Certified / Travelers Checks, or Money Orders, or Wire Transfers (please fax a copy of bank confirmation when wiring funds) are accepted forms of donation at any time. Credit Cards (Discover, Visa and Master Card) will incur an additional 3% charge to cover the processing fees. In order to speed the processing of deposits and final donations, please note the departure date on deposit and balance of donation checks. Every reservation must be accompanied by a signed application form. Returned checks will incur a \$25 service fee. In case of computer or human billing error, we reserve the right to re-invoice with corrected billing.

PRICE GUARANTEE: We can only guarantee prices when and if the pilgrimage package cost is paid in full.

NOT INCLUDED: Airport / air transport taxes / fuel surcharges, items of a personal nature, such as telephone, room service, lunch, snacks, alcoholic beverages, optional activities, and laundry. Tips to guides (\$5/day) and drivers (\$ varies per bag) and medical / travel insurance (\$ varies based on age and package cost). Please carefully review all tour information.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: A valid passport is required for travel. If you are not a US citizen, please consult your local **Bosnia-Herzegovina and Croatia / Ireland** consulate.. Cancellations due to lack of appropriate travel documents will incur usual penalties. A legible copy of the passport photo page must be sent to both **Great Experiences** and the **PFMC** preferably with registration application. Names on tickets must match passport information. Final documents are issued upon receipt of final donation only and within usually not until **2 weeks** of departure. Upon receipt of your documents you are responsible to check your itinerary, spelling of your name, dates, times and other important information. Read all correspondence carefully and completely. Be on time.

Tickets will show the actual costs at time of ticketing. Add-on air connections may be requested to transport pilgrims to and from the departure airport.

BAGGAGE: The less the better. If in doubt, leave it at home. Each pilgrim is advised to bring one suitcase and one small overnight bag. The airlines' free baggage allowance is two checked pieces. The sum of dimensions (length + width + height) for each item cannot exceed 62 inches. **Great Experiences** and the **PFMC** are not responsible for loss, theft, delay, or damage to a baggage.

SEAT ASSIGNMENT: Random seat assignments are made for all pilgrims. If you would like to secure a specific seat, or sit with a companion please have all parties at the airport at least three hours prior to departure and try to arrange the desired seat assignment with your airline's check-in or gate agent.

TRANSFERS: Our programs include group round-trip transfers. Passengers arriving or leaving independently must transfer at their own expense. No smoking is allowed on motor coach.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Hotel accommodations are based on twin-bedded rooms; in some countries double beds are possible. **Great Experiences** reserves the right to substitute similar category hotels or religious houses without prior notice. No reductions are available for triple rooms.
