in support of Shannon Anti-War Activists on Trial

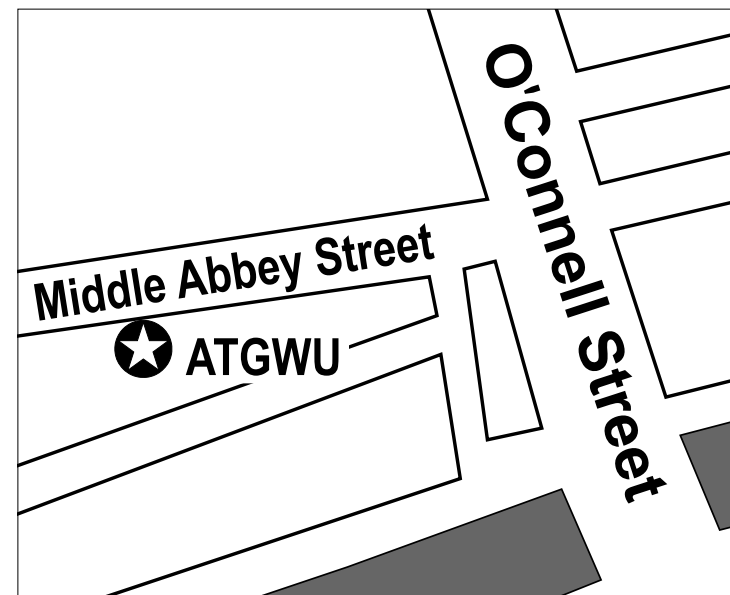
America's most significant independent journalist Amy Goodman of 'Democracy Now' speaks about the US corporate media's coverage of the Iraq War and the way that the media has downplayed civilian casualties while glorifying military combat.

At the core of her lecture is a deep commitment to the ethics of journalism – she believes that the role of reporters is to ferret out the facts, to question those in power, and to 'go to where the silence is, and say something.'

Amy Goodman uses the the Iraq war to ask her audience to grapple with a larger question – what impact does the commercialisation and consolidation of the media industry have on journalism and democracy?
