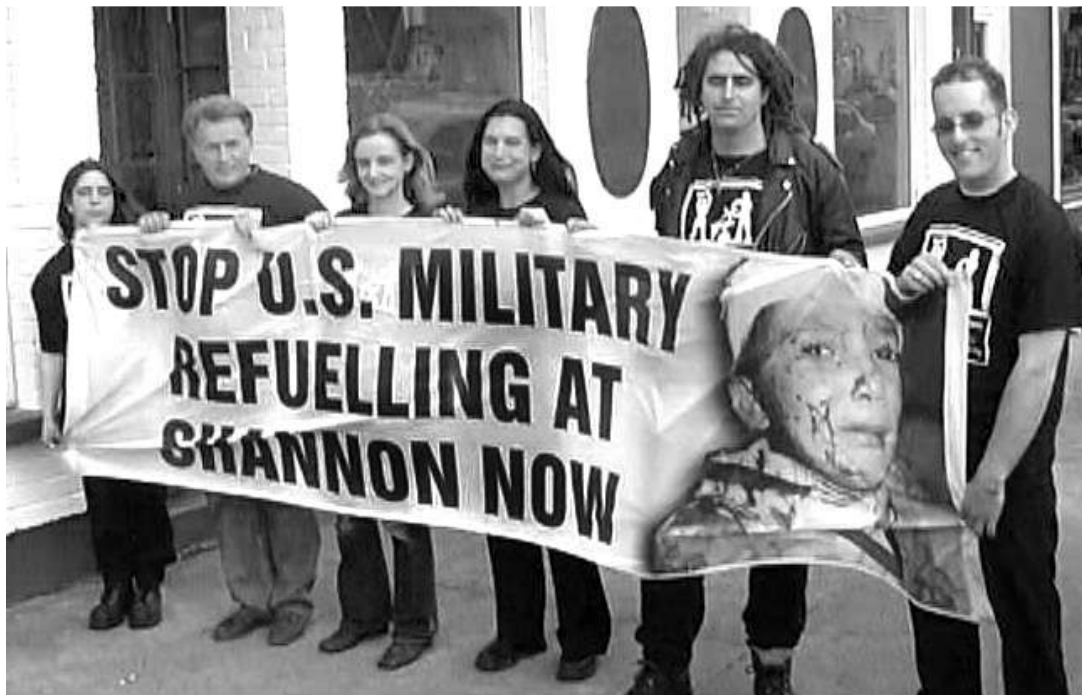
PIT STOP PLOUGHSHARES PUT THE IRAQ WAR ON TRIAL MARCH 7TH 2005

10,000 U.S. troops a month continue to commute through Shannon Airport on their way to the invasion, occupation and plunder of Iraq. The Irish Government has transformed a civilian airport into a militarised pitstop for the U.S. war machine.
