Once again the Pusat Majudiri Y worked alongside Nokia to provide interpreting services for Deaf users of Nokia handphones during their roadshows in KL, Klang, Penang and Kuantan. The Deaf members had the opportunity to have their enquiries attended to and participated in the games organised by Nokia. Workshops on Mobile Technology by the Nokia staff was held in YMCA Penang and Kuantan Deaf Club for its members. We will be organising a few workshops in KL with them in July/Aug. 2

FOD Sessions

To enhance their signing skills and interaction with the Deaf community, sessions for members who are basically students of sign language were held every fortnight on 2nd and 4th Thursdays. The variety of programmes and activities help members enhance their vocabulary signing skills. Some of these activities were:

- 1) **Basic skin care (13 March)** which was facilitated by Ms Mona Khoo, a beautician and member of FOD. Besides learning about skin care, members also learn the various sign associated to this topic.
- 2) **Scrabble in sign language (22 May)** -- a very entertaining session with lots of laughter and fun. For each word the members created, they have to sign. This provided a lot of challenge to the group.
- 3) **Songs in sign language (19 April)** -- It was a time for "singing with their hands" for the members as they sang their favourite songs and at the same time signed it as well.
- 4) **Signing in pictorial sequence (12 June)** provided the members with a lot of practice to visualise the story. The attendance of some Deaf members in these sessions helped members to improve their signs.

The course include role and responsibility of a sign language instructor, setting up / coordinating sign language programmes, code of ethics, what is Bahasa Isyarat Malaysia (BIM) and specific guidelines required of teachers of sign language.

Programme with Penang YMCA 3 & 4 Mac 2003,

A 2-day workshop on Visual Gesture Communication was carried out for members & staff of the Penang YMCA. In addition to that the PMY staff/ Volunteer also carried out a Teens & Leadership Development programme for Deaf Teens from YMCA and schools for the Deaf.

Berita ringkas tentang "Scuba Diving" oleh Kelab Pekak, 15--19 Jun 2003

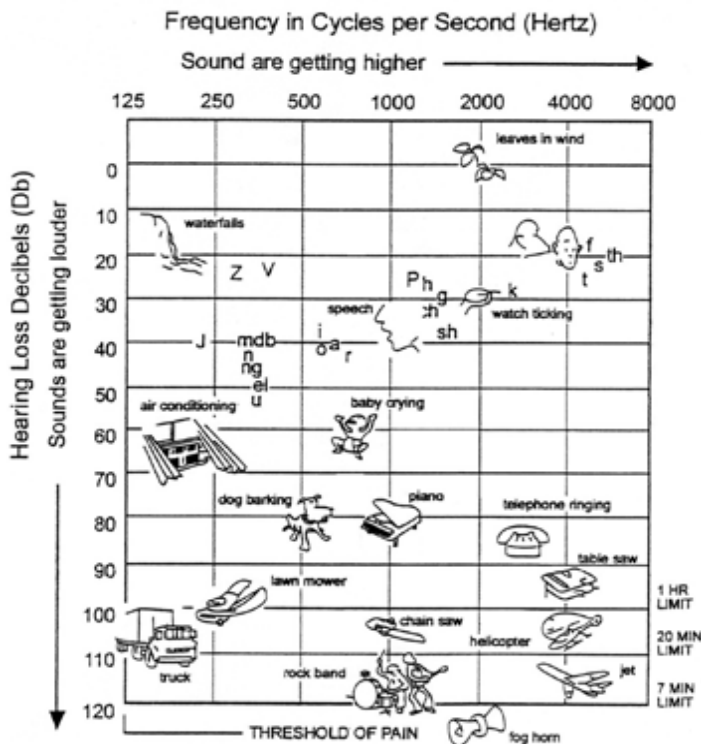

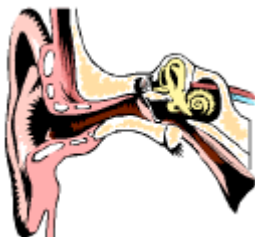
Understanding Hearing Loss

A General Guide on Understanding Hearing Loss



Types Of Hearing Loss

- ⇒ **Conductive Hearing Loss** – Occurs when there is a problem in the transmission of sound vibrations in outer or middle ear.
- ⇒ **Sensori-neural Hearing Loss** – Occurs when there is a problem in the inner ear (cochlea or the hearing nerve). Therefore, sound cannot be converted to electrical signals or sent by the nerve to the brain that carry sound waves to the brain.
- ⇒ **Mixed Hearing Loss** - Occurs when there is a problem in both the external / middle ear and the inner ear.



Classification Of Hearing Loss

- ⇒ **Normal** : 10 – 25 decibels (dB)
- ⇒ **Slight** : 25 – 40 dB loss
- ⇒ **Mild to Moderate** : 40 – 55 dB loss
- ⇒ **Moderately severe** : 55 – 70 dB loss
- ⇒ **Severe** : 70 – 90 dB loss
- ⇒ **Profound Loss** : Over 90 dB loss

Some causes of Hearing Loss

- ⇒ An inherited condition (common cause)
- ⇒ **German measles** (Rubella) during pregnancy
- ⇒ **Prematurity** – deprivation of oxygen and neonatal jaundice.
- ⇒ **Diseases** – scarlet fever, mumps, measles, whooping cough, diphtheria, Pneumonia, influenza, meningitis.
- ⇒ **Chemicals** – aspirin and other drugs that a person is allergic to.
- ⇒ **Trauma to the Head or ear**
- ⇒ **Loud Noises** – usually over a period of time.
- ⇒ **Ear Wax and Infections** – if not taken care of.

Hearing Test

A hearing test should be conducted by a qualified Audiologist who is a specialist, trained to perform and to interpret all the various hearing test. Various methods are used to carry out a Hearing Test. The appropriate method to be used for testing a person's hearing usually depends on the age of the person. They include the following:

- ⇒ Examination of the Ears
- ⇒ Auditory Brainstem Evoked Response (ABR)
- ⇒ Oto Acoustic Emission (OAE)
- ⇒ Audiometry
- ⇒ Speech Perception Testing
- ⇒ Tympanometry

Some signs that may indicate a hearing loss

Do you:

- ⇒ need the television sound volume higher than is comfortable for others?
- ⇒ request frequent repetition or sometimes misunderstand people?
- ⇒ find that people complain about unanswered telephones and doorbells?
- ⇒ avoid social occasions or noisy situations?
- ⇒ wish that others would stop mumbling when they speak?
- ⇒ find following a group conversation difficult?
- ⇒ find it difficult to determine where a sound came from?
- ⇒ worry that your memory or concentration is failing?

If the answer to any of these questions is yes, it is possible that you have developed a hearing loss. It is important to seek advice as soon as possible.
