Dear Mr. Lavine:

I am writing to you as the President of the Project Challenge Parent Association in the Plainview Old-Bethpage School District. The mission of our organization is to “promote and support gifted education and related activities” within the District. Towards this end, we wish to make you aware of our strong support for Assembly bill A01502 which proposes to “to ensure the provisions of educational services for gifted and talented students.”

The justifications listed for the bill coincide exactly with the statements we have been making to our Administration and Board of Education. We were especially drawn to the justification paragraph in which the author states that education is not a zero sum game; that providing funds to comply with the No Child Left Behind legislation does not mean that funds need to be withheld from educating special needs students at the other end of the academic spectrum.

It is vital that our teachers become aware of how to properly recognize and educate our gifted and talented children. The undersigned members of the organization and I believe that bill A01502 reflects this and we urge you to support the bill.

We are sending a similar letter to Senator Hannon. We hope that with your support in the Assembly and his in the Senate, a gifted education bill can pass in the near future.
